The family history of Edward Alexander FISHER and Margaret Isabelle LUESTRANGE

Edward Alexander FISHER (boy) was born on the 13 March 1847 at 25 Brooksby Street South Islington Middlesex England. His parents were Harriet formerly PALMER and Thomas FISHER occupation Clerk in an Insurance Office. Edward's father Thomas FISHER of 25 Brooksby Street, South Islington registered the birth on 20 April 1847. The registrar was John Watts.

Doris LESSELS formerly HARRIS was told that her grandfather Edward Alexander FISHER had connection with an Archbishop FISHER of Canterbury in England but so far I have been unable to prove any connection.

SEARCH 1871 census for Edward FISHER or FISCHER aged about 24 born Islington Greater London Middlesex.

Edward did not leave England for New Zealand until 1874 but I have been unable to locate him on an 1871 census, as he was not living with his parents at that time.

Edward Alexander FISHER left England on “*La Hogue*” 20/24 February 1874 and arrived in the Port of Wellington NZ on 26 May 1874. He was registered as an assisted emigrant, aged 22 years from Country Middlesex and occupation Porter. Cost of passage money to the Government was £14.10.0.

When Edward Alexander FISHER arrived in Wellington he then travelled to the South Island and settled in Matarua Southland arriving there around 1874 this is according to his 1880 intention to marry application.

Around 1875 the Matarua River was bridged and Matarua’s paper mills began production. Matarua School was also opened in 1875. The railway line from Invercargill to Gore was opened either 1875 or 1878. I located 2 dates in 2 different publications. The first newspaper in Gore named “The Matarua Ensign” began publication in 1878.

A petition to the Municipal Council of Otago dated 01 June 1874 from 24 Matarua Bridge Inhabitants wrote protesting about the traffic on the Sabbath included reference about Hotelkeepers and storekeepers etc. Edward FISHER was not recorded on the Petition.

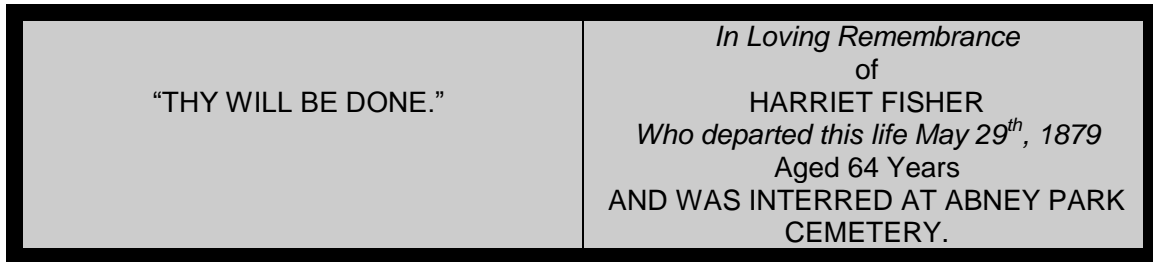
Mr Dear Brother

It is with sad heart I have to write to you of the death of our dear mother, which took place 2 weeks ago May 29th. Her suffering latterly over fearful the last month she lived I was up with her night & day never had my clothes off had to have a nurse the last 16 nights to watch with me. I got so tired out as I told you in my last letter she had failed very much the last 12 months but the last days of her life she was confined to her room you know how stout she used to be but she got too nothing but skin and bone you may judge what she got like for the last few weeks of her life. I carried her about in my arms from the bed to the chair. She was quite helpless her last month here you know Ted I am not over much strength. I have enclosed one of her cards. Do write sometime when you receive this but address to me thus, as we are leaving here in a week or so. Miss FISHER, Care of Rev I J Stone, St Pauls Vicarage, Dalstou London. Oh Ted you little know how I miss her there seems such a blank which nothing can fill and nursing of her so long made her terribly dear to me we were as much to each other she did cling to me so particular the last month she was unconscious for 16 hours before death but the last hour she came too she knew me and said O'Dear O'Dear after a little time she said to me lift me up which I did at 5 minutes before 11 in the morning of the 29th she said to me O'Dear in 5 minutes and as the clock struck 11 she breathed her last in my arms. We think as there is now only Papa & Hayley left we shall go to Folkestone/Fathestone (sic) to live it is to be settled next week. Papa is going tomorrow to look for a place. Kate and Alf and their little ones are all quite well. Jack was blessed with another daughter on the 8th of this month making number two. Now Ted I must leave off I truly feel for you losing her and being so far off may she who sent this heavy wish gives the comfort believe me your loving sister.

Margaret Isabella LUESTRANG was born between 1850 & 1853 in Dublin Ireland.
SEARCH (Reference Irish birth registration for Margaret LESTRANGE Dublin Ireland)

Margaret LESTRANGE left England on the "Carrick Castle" 27 April 1874 and arrived in Bluff Otago NZ on 14 July 1874. She was registered as an assisted emigrant aged 24 years from County Dublin Ireland and occupation Cook. Cost of passage money to the Government was £14.10.0.

In 1871 the Carrick Castle 879 tons, Captain Peters, sailed April 22nd, arrived August 4th New Zealand with 33 passengers. I have been unable to locate any information regarding the 1874 voyage in the publication "White Wings".

In 1874 after Margaret Isabelle LESTRANGE arrived in Otago she travelled to Matura Southland arriving there around 1878 this is according to her 1880 intention to marry application.

Intention to marry 15 April 1880 Matura district
Edward Alexander FISHER age 29 bachelor occupation Clerk dwelled Matura 6 years and Margaret Isabelle LUESTRANGE aged 28 spinster dwelled Matura 18 months intend to marry in the Cameron's Hotel Matura by the Presbyterian minister Rev J M DAVIDSON.

Edward A FISHER aged 29 years bachelor occupation Clerk married Margaret Isabella LUESTRANGE aged 28 spinster. They married in the Cameron's Hotel Matura on the 17th day of April 1880 at the hour of three o'clock pm. The witnesses were Hugh CAMERON Hotel Keeper of Matura and J S SHANKS Corn Agent Matura. The officiating minister was J M DAVIDSON. Both couples signed their names as Ed FISHER and M I LUESTRANGE.

Edward Alexander FISHER and Margaret Isabelle LUESTRANGE married at Matura Saturday 17th April 1880.

Margaret was a catholic so it was most unusual for her to be married by a Presbyterian minister. There was no Catholic church in the area only the Presbyterian Church that was established in Matura around 1874.

Perhaps H Cameron employed Margaret at the Cameron Hotel as cook and J S Shanks employed Edward as a clerk. This is only a theory and has to be research or confirmed.

I have a photograph of the two story Cameron’s Hotel, also known as the Matura Hotel where Margaret and Edward were married in 1880. The Matura Hotel was situated opposite the Railway Station.

I have a publication “MATAURA City of the Falls” edited by D.C. W. Muir that gives a good account of Matura in those early years when Edward and Margaret lived in Matura. There is also a photo of the Cameron Hotel in the publication.

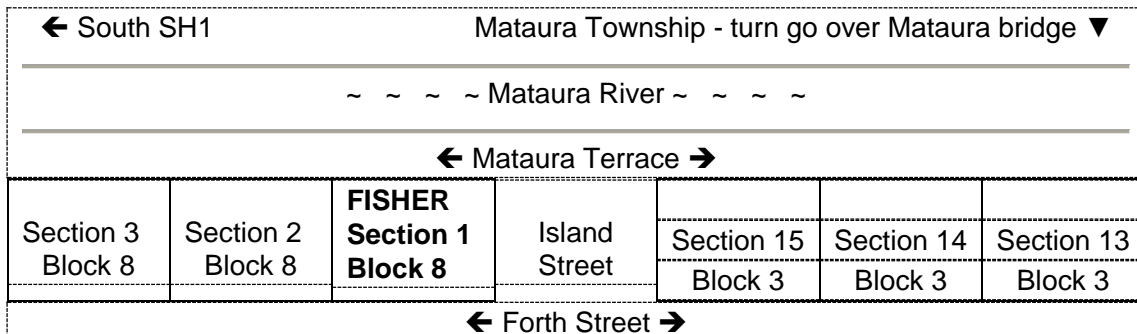

I have a map of Matura showing Section 1 block 8 Matura Bridge where Edward resided. When you travel over the bridge turn to the right then when the road splits turn right into Forth Street (not Kana Street) after this take the 1st turn right which is Island Street. The land takes up the whole block from Forth Street on left to Matura Terrace on the right and backs onto the river.



Three years after Edward and Margaret married they had a daughter Charlotte Reginald FISHER who was born 03 June 1883 in Matarua NZ. The birth registration recorded father Edward Alexander FISHER aged 32 years born Dover Kent England occupation Clerk and mother Margaret Leustrange aged 30 years born Havre France. The

registration states that they married on the 17th April 1880 in Matura. The father E A FISHER of Matura registered the birth on 8 June 1883 in Matura district.

Edward and Margaret moved from Matura to Invercargill between 1884 and 1885

Edward and Margaret had a daughter Harriet Agnes FISHER who was born at 5.30 pm on 07 April 1885 either at Avenal or Long bush Invercargill New Zealand.

Avenal is a suburb of Invercargill and Long bush is situated 13 km east of Invercargill

I have searched but have been unable to locate Harriet's birth registration. Harriet's youngest daughter Vera confirmed that they always celebrated their mother's birthday on 07 April. We also located details on a piece of paper written by Edward in regard to Harriet's birth. These details are transcribed below.

"Harriet born at Avenal (Avenal) Invercargill on 7th April 1885 at 5.30 pm".

I had been told that a French Nun taught Harriet handwork so I asked an Invercargill genealogist to search the Catholic school registers for Harriet Agnes FISHER but no records could be found for Harriett.

I wrote to the Catholic Diocesan Archives (300 Rattray Street Dunedin phone (03) 477 2980) enquiring about the baptisms Harriet in 1885 and her sister Charlotte in 1883. The cost for both records was \$20 and the details are as follows.

Catholic Church baptisms 1893

Margaret and Edward A FISHER their daughters were baptised in Waikiwi Invercargill by Father N VEREKER. Charlotte FISHER was recorded as born 03 June 1883 and baptised 18 April 1894 and her younger sister Harriet Mary FISHER (known as Harriet Agnes FISHER) was recorded as born 07 April 1885 and baptised 20 April 1894 Waikiwi 2 days after her older sister. Their godmother was Mary GAVIN

There was no trace for a Margaret or Margaret Isabella FISHER on the 1893 Awarua and/Invercargill Electoral Roll which was the year that New Zealand Women received the vote. I did however locate a Margaret FISHER on the 1893 and 1896 Wallace Electoral roll and details are as follows:

I was told that Edward purchased and managed a farm in Long bush but because he had no experience in farming he eventually had to walk off the land.

SEARCH NZ Gazette Land ballot notices for Longbush Invercargill and read local history on Invercargill land sales.

I was told by a descendant that while farming Edward became bankrupt. I searched the bankruptcy records and found no information regarding any bankruptcy for Edward Alexander FISHER.

Catholic Church baptism 1894

Charlotte FISHER was recorded as born 03 June 1883 and baptised 18 April 1894 in Waikiwi by Father N VEREKER. Her parents were recorded as Margaret and Edward A FISHER and her godmother was Mary GAVIN. Charlotte would have been 10 years 10 months old at the time of her baptism.

I believe the FISHER family was living in Waikiwi around 1894 but according to the intention to marry of Edward's daughter Harriet the family moved to Waikiwi around 1895 and according to his other daughter Charlotte's intention to marry it was around 1898.

Edward Alexander FISHER aged 66 years born London England occupation Gardner died 20 October 1916 at Invercargill Hospital. Cause of death was Pneumonia for 10 days and Cardiac failure 3 days duration of illness as certified by I Woodhouse. Edward was buried on 22 October 1916, at St Johns Cemetery Waikiwi by Church of England minister G FYNCH-CLINTON. He had dwelled in New Zealand for 40 years (arrival 1876 but was actually 1874) married aged 28 years to Margaret Isabelle LUESTRANGE who was also deceased. His living issue was 2 females aged 36 and 31 years old. George W Fraser an Undertaker from Invercargill registered the death on 24 October 1916.

Edward Alexander FISHER died at Invercargill on Friday 20 October 1916 at 1.15 pm age 66
(Reference written in a bible by his daughter Harriett held by son Male living Harris of Queensland Australia)

Edward Alexander FISHER was buried at St John's Churchyard Waikiwi Invercargill in Block XX (20) Section 9b, which was purchased by James J Brokensha. Directions on locating the grave are, enter the St John's cemetery entrance on Durham Street Waikiwi

and walk towards Block 20, which is on the right. Walk down the left side of block 20. Edward FISHER is buried in an unmarked plot 9b (9th plot in) with the grave marked WEB on his right side and WARD in the plot behind him. I have visited St John's cemetery and taken a photograph of the grave, which is placed in the file.

Sadly she stopped writing to her sister Harriet. Charlotte never returned to New Zealand but died in Canada. I do not have the death registration or burial details for Charlotte Reginald LEE.

In the 1960s a son of Charlotte's sister Harriet travelled to Canada and employed a private detective who located Charlotte's son Robert. Robert and his wife Helen made many trips to New Zealand and we all have wonderful memories of them both.

Charlotte's son Robert Anthony LEE died on 08 January 1999 at South Okanagan General Hospital Oliver British Columbia Canada and was interred at the Garden of Gethsemane Surrey British Columbia Canada. His funeral notice reads:

I thought Samuel may have been related to Margaret but again I could not prove any connection. There are some other details held in the family file regarding L'ESTRANGE surnames in Ireland from the late Joe CASSIN of Wellington.

The surname L'ESTRANGE originated in Westmeath Ireland.

LESTRANGE – This is the only form now in use of the Westmeath name Mac Conchoigcríche (border hound), formerly anglicised Mac-Enkegry. The adoption of the modern anglicised form may have been due to the existence in Westmeath of an English family called Lestrangle who settled there in the sixteenth century. By the 1820s and 1830s the appearance of many Irish towns had been improved by the building of smart little town-houses, often in terraces, and suitable for the nascent middle class. A universal feature of such houses was a handsome doorway with a leaded fanlight. Pages 206 and 207 show a selection of these. The houses in the Mall, Waterford, are important ones, provincial rivals of Merrion Square. Charlemont Place is a terrace of superior houses in the Mall at Armagh, built of local limestone ashlar and having wrought-iron balconies. The low two-storey house at Cloghan, Co Offaly, which belonged to the **Lestrange family**, is much simpler, its only pretension to refinement being the doorway.
