## <u>Sisters of Our Lady of the Missions = Provincial Archive records</u>

The order of the Sisters of Our Lady of the Missions began in New Zealand as early as 1865 with the arrival in Napier of four Sisters of this order from Frances. By 1868 the first postulant had joined the order for training her in New Zealand

The Archives of the Sisters of Our Lady of the Missions hold over 800 records of every postulant who entered this order from all over New Zealand since 1868. Records of Sisters who emigrated from other countries to serve in New Zealand however are not complete.

The records include = date and place of birth – date of Postulancy – date of novitiate – date of first vows – date of final vows – date of death or leaving order.

These provincial archival records may be especially valuable to researcher who cannot trace a female member but have reason to believe that person may have entered a religious order. Enquires are welcome but should include a stamped and addressed envelope.

## St John Church Trentham Upper Hutt

563 Fergusson Drive Trentham Upper Hutt

The St John's Church was built in 1863 on land donated by Richard BARTON. Extentions were done in 1908, 1956 and 1986. It is one of the oldest churches in the Wellington district and also one of Upper Hutt oldest buildings. Services are still held in the Church. The Lych gate are a memorial to those who served in the First World War.

The church grave yard has 917 polts and ashes plots. Many early Upper Hutt settlers are buried in the church grave yard and include the families of Barton, Benge, Cruickshank, Robinson, Schwartz and Whiteman plus many others who have contributed to Upper Hutt History.

Transcriptions of the burial register in time will be placed on the Friends of St John's website. Some headstone inscriptions have been transcribed by members of the New Zealand Society of Genealogists and copies of the transcriptions are available at the Heritage centre in Petone Library. The earliest burial in July 1865 is Fanny Matilda Robinson who was aged 2 years.

The St John's Church has a short history recorded on their website and an additional history is planned to be published in 2012.
