Fire - Big Housewarming at Upper Hutt

On Tuesday night the two decker house on the main road owned by Mrs James Greenwood was totally destroyed by fire. Until Christmas week the house had been tenanted by Mr H R Pearson, and some furniture sold by him to Mrs McCurdy was still in the house awaiting removal by Mr Geange who had undertaken to deliver it to the purchaser before Xmas. Dr Kemp also had a quantity of books and papers stowed away under the stairs but he states they are no great loss to him. Notice of the house being vacant had been given to the local insurance agent Mr P D Davis. A couple of weeks ago the house was let to Miss Smoothy, who would have been in occupation had the paperhanger been able to carry out his work at an earlier date. The last person known to have been in the house was the owner herself, who left the building about 1 pm after cleaning the premises thoroughly. In the evening her son Leslie went down the side passage to close a window she had left open, and this he did without entering the house. This was between 6 and 6.30 pm, and there was no indication of fire at that time. About 9.30 Mrs James Brown, of Martin Street, noticed smoke issuing from the building and raised an alarm. On the building being entered it was found the fire had a very strong hold and that in the absence of a water supply, the house was doomed. The heat was intense the copper wires of the telegraph line were melted, and Wilkinson's store and Mr W Greenwood's house, a chain away, were charred and only saved by the vigorous efforts of a scratch volunteer bucket-brigade. Fortunately it was a calm night, otherwise the business portion of Upper Hutt would have gone up in smoke. Towards 11 o'clock all danger of the fire spreading had practically ceased, but a watch had to be kept owing to a light puffy wind springing up towards midnight. The lower portion of the building was of kauri and built to the order of the Bank of New Zealand, and was used as a branch of that institution with a resident manager for some time. An upper storey was added after the bank sold the property and the building was utilised as a boarding house until Mr Pearson entered into occupation. The premises were insured in the Commercial Union for £500 but as the property is within the "brick" area proclaimed on Mr Davis motion when a town commissioner, it cannot be reinstated in timber.

News of the Day - The Upper Hutt Township had a narrow escape from a serious fire on Tuesday night. A fourteen roomed house, used as a boarding house, belonging to Mrs James Greenwood, was discovered to be on fire soon after 9 o'clock and all efforts to subdue the outbreak were unavailing. Fortunately the wind, a light zephyr, wafted the flames away from the adjoining building, otherwise the fire would have continued up the main street. The boarding house, which was completely destroyed, had been empty since Christmas, and was receiving an overhaul, preparatory to a new tenant taking possession, and there was no sign of fire at 6 o'clock. The building was insured for £500 in the Commercial Union office.
