Robert STOKES was born 1809 Jamaica. His parents were Martha Frances nee BARKER and Robert STOKES

Margaret PUGHE was born 06 November 1785 Liverpool Lancashire and baptised 13 February 1786 St Nicholas Liverpool Lancashire England. Her parents were Ann nee Wordsworth and Lewis Pughe.
