Mary Smith THOMSON wife of John THOMSON of the Upper Hutt in the Province District of Wellington Saddler I give devise and bequeath all my real and personal estate of whatever nature and wherever situated unto my sister Barbara Gray of Elizabeth Street in the City of Wellington widow (hereafter referred to as my trustee) upon trust that my trustee shall sell all and convert into money the sum of such part there of as shall not consist of money and shall with and out of the moneys produces by such sale calling in and conversion and with and out of my ready money pay and discharge my debts and funeral and testamentary expenses and shall stand possessed of the balance of such moneys o the real or personal estate that shall remain unsold and unconverted as hereinafter provide upon trust to allow my said husband the use during his lifetime of the property situated at the Upper Hutt aforesaid being the Allotment number twenty nine (29) on the subdivision plan of section numbered One Hundred and nineteen (119) Upper Hutt District deposited in the Deeds Registry Office at Wellington as Number 135 subject to the paramount by him the said John Thomson of the weekly subscription instalments and sums of money due by me upon the shares held by me in the Number One (1) Co-Operative Building Society of Wellington and upon trust to allow my said husband the use during his lifetime of the furniture and household goods belonging to me contained in the buildings erected upon the said parcel of land and upon trust to hold the balance of my estate both real and personal and also from and after the decease of my said husband the real and personal property above described for the sole use and benefit of my daughter Ada Annie Thomson and I declare that my said trustee may at her own discretion apply any of the funds at her disposal under the trusts here of for the maintenance support and education of my said daughter and I also declare that my trustee postpone the sale and conversion of any part of my real and personal estate for so long as she shall think fit and I also empower my trustee to expel my said husband from the land and premises above described and to determine the lift interest of him my said husband therein and also to the furniture and household goods contained in the said building as aforesaid is and whenever he shall make default for one calendar month in payment of the weekly subscription and payable as aforesaid in respect of my shares in the number one (1) Co-Operative Building Society of Wellington as aforesaid and in case of the determination of such tenancy occupation and interest as aforesaid I empower my said trustee to deal with such property by sale lease or otherwise as she may deem most expedient and I appoint the said Barbara Gray sole executive and trustee of this my will. In Witness where I have hereunto subscribed my name, this fifth day of February One thousand eight hundred and ninety eight.

I Barbara Gray of the City of Wellington widow make oath I am the sister of Mary Smith Thomson deceased domiciled in Upper Hutt died at Upper Hutt on tenth day August 1899 (various other details and documents regarding Mary's probate)
