1897 Drowning in Hutt River – 3 deaths

The Hutt Drowning Case – Pathetic Particulars – The discovery of yesterday's terrible drowning accident in the Hutt River which resulted in the death of Mrs Annetta Hope her stepdaughter Miss Lillian Hope aged 20 and her infant child Annetta was made by Mr A McCulloch of Trentham.

Mr McCulloch was returning home from the Lower Hutt and on entering the gorge about a mile below the railway bridge over the Hutt river he noticed wheel marks close to the edge of the road. Pulling up he saw that an accident had taken place for about 20 feet down a horse and trap were in the river while some of the bushes at the side of the road sere broken down. M'Culloch called to Messrs H Quarterman and J Phillips who were a short distance away and the three got down to the water where they found the trap upside down pinning the two ladies under water. The bodies were at once got out but were lifeless as was also that of the baby, which was held tightly by one of the ladies. There was only about four feet of water at the spot and the horse was found with its head out of water against a. bank, uninjured. Little damage had been done to the trap and even the baby's bottle was unbroken. When Mr M'Culloch first noticed the bodies he saw that they were dead and that it would have been impossible to get them out from the trap without other assistance. The bodies have been taken to Mr Hope's house in Stokes's Valley where an inquest is being held this afternoon. In explanation of the accident it is stated in reports furnished by the police and our correspondent at Upper Hutt, that Mrs Hope evidently did not understand much about driving. As the trap was going up the Hutt Gorge the horse must have jibbed at the incline, and backed the cart over the side of the road into the river, a fall of 20ft. The road is wide at the spot, and the wheel marks show that the horse must have backed about half a chain before going over. Mrs Hope must have become frightened and held all the tighter to the reins when the horse began to back. Otherwise, there was plenty of time for the occupants of the trap to have jumped out. A sad feature about the accident is that Mr Hope, who was in Wellington when it happened, only heard of the deaths when he opened the Evening Post yesterday evening. He was naturally greatly shocked, and much sympathy will be felt for him in his triple bereavement.
