# **Section Two – Upper Hutt Cemeteries**

This section lists only the service personnel who served in World War One. Some of the personnel are buried in the cemeteries while others have their names recorded on family headstones in the Upper Hutt district. There are two churchyards St John's and St Joseph's in Upper Hutt and there are two cemeteries Akatarawa and Wallaceville.



## St Johns Churchyard

St John's Church is situated on the corner of Fergusson Drive and Moonshine Road.

There is a World War One memorial plaque on the wall inside St John's church †††. In the churchyard a few family headstones record the names of personnel who died overseas †. Some personnel who died in New Zealand before or after discharge from wounds or disease received while on active duty are also buried in the churchyard ††. The remainder personnel after discharge resided locally then when they died were buried in St John's churchyard.

# St Joseph's Churchyard

St Joseph's Church is situated on the corner of Pine Avenue and Main Street in Upper Hutt.

The old St Joseph's church was dismantled on 15 April 1961 and a new church was built. The headstones in the churchyard were removed and the area around the church was grassed. The names of those buried in St Joseph's churchyard are listed on the back wall of the new church with access from Pine Avenue. There is no indication of any war service next to the names recorded on the wall.

The 29 Dec 1917 Hutt Valley Independent newspaper reads:-

"To our Protestant readers we can point with pride to the list of Upper Hutt Catholic Parish Defenders of the Flag here is the list – Three sons each of J Boyle and J Hagan – Two sons each D Kelly, J Martin, F O'Leary and Mrs Paul – One each Craig, Mrs Golder, W Jones, W McCrossin, Mrs Quinn, J Shout, A Southee and Mrs Young – brothers Jno Brown, Mrs J Cunniffe and Mrs W Stephenson – husband Mrs Fox – also Father Daly and T J McMahon S/m of Kaitoke and of these 29 Catholics, 18 are Irish and 7 of the 29 have made the supreme sacrifice".

The list of the Service Personnel below was created from the information in the newspaper article above. Some personnel had strong connections to the Upper Hutt district while others only family connections but is the only located military link to St Joseph's so far.

Some members of the same family enlisted after the newspaper article was printed. Mrs Quinn, Mrs Golder, W Jones and W McCrossin all had two sons each that enlisted in World War One. Mrs W Stephenson nee Tarrant had two brothers who served not one. The four extra personnel have been added making a new total of 33.
