Colonel William LECKIE retired in 1875 and left for New Zealand the following year.

There were no passenger list for the LECKIE family but the details above came from the Wellington Immigration register which lists passengers who disembarked in Port of Wellington which then gave them entitlement to land grants. Emigrated from London arrived 12 January 1876 on ship "Pleides" to port Wellington. Amount entitles to for land purchase £110. Date of Agent Generals Certificate 17 September 1876 Remarks lapsed.

William LECKIE ex Colonel of HM 63 Regiment aged 59 years died on 26 August 1884 Adelaide Road Wellington. Cause of death was Diseased Liver Prostration as certified by Dr Driver who last saw him on 25 August. He was born in Ireland and his parents were Elizabeth nee MCCLURE and James Henry LECKIE a Captain of HM 39th Regiment. He had dwelled in New Zealand for 8 years (1876). Church of England minister Reverend R COFFEY buried him on 29 August 1884 in Wellington. He was married age 29 in London to Henrietta WINNING. His living issue were 4 males aged 29, 26, 23 & 19. The undertaker M NICHOLSON of Wellington registered the death. On the 08 September 1886 a correction of former entry was witnessed by Norman L GUN, A W LECKIE In correction of Entry No 292/84.

The death occurred suddenly at his home "Tyttenhanger" Heretaunga yesterday morning of Frank Maxwell Leckie a retired civil servant and an old resident of Wellington who was held in the highest regard. Mr Leckie who was 70 years of age was the son of Colonel William Leckie of the 39th Dorset Regiment who on his retirement from the Army settled in Wellington and became actively associated with the development of the city. He was for a term a member of the board of Governors of the Wellington Colleges.

Mr Leckie attended Wellington College from 1873 to 1882. He joined the Civil Service as a cadet in the Government Life Insurance Department in 1884 and continued in that department until August 1902 when he was transferred to the Pensions Department from which he retired on superannuation in 1921. He represented Wellington in Rugby football in 1884 and 1885 and won the old boys race at the annual college sports in 1883, 1887 and 1933. A noted runner he was a member of the Wellington Amateur Athletic club and as a footballer he played for the Athletic club.

Mr Leckie spent the last two or three years of his life compiling "The Early History of Wellington College from 1867 to 1883". This work occupied him for a considerable time but it was to him a labour of love. As no one had sought to keep in any kind of over records of the college Mr Leckie's task was no easy one. In the face of some discouragement but with the cheerful help of many well-wishers he persisted in his task and the result is one that old boys of the college fully appreciate. It was Mr Leckie's intention to follow the first volume by publishing a record one bringing his history of the college down to the end of the century and later if he were spared he had in mind a third volume that would bring the history right up to date and so lay the foundations of a permanent all-time record.

Mr Leckie leaves a widow, three sons and two daughters. The sons are Messrs F.F. (Bill) Leckie Dunedin, J D Leckie Upper Hutt, and T.W.M. Leckie Wellington. The daughters are Mesdames Rewi Murray of Christchurch and Foster of Singapore (wife of Mr Julian Foster who was trade commissioner for the United States in New Zealand for some years).
