Letter of introduction for William GILLIES (1873)

Edinburgh 14 March 1873  
Presented to William GILLIES Upholsterer Edinburgh previously to his leaving Edinburgh to emigrate to Canada America. The great, great, great, great grandfather of the said William GILLIES Upholsterer as above stated was James GILLIES farmer upon the estate of Philip Haugh Sil Kirkshire whose son was William GILLIES Ploughman Selkirk who married Elspeth ANDERSON from Fife and had eleven children of whom the eldest was Samuel GILLIES Thatcher married Margaret MURRAY of Selkirk and had seven children of whom the eldest William GILLIES Mason left Selkirk when a young man came to Edinburgh and settled there where he married Margaret daughter of John WILSON Market Gardner Edinburgh and had five sons and one daughter namely Samuel, Adam who both died while infants Samuel, Isabela, William and John the father of the said children William GILLIES died 26<sup>th</sup> October 1805 age 40 or 41 years and Margaret spouse to the said William GILLIES also died 26 March 1806 aged 34 years also their daughter Isabela died 14 June 1807 age 10 years their third son Samuel GILLIES born on the 9<sup>th</sup> May 1795 and married Elizabeth daughter of George SOMMERVILLE Ormiston on the 20<sup>th</sup> November 1822 their first son Robert Halliwall GILLIES was born on the 6<sup>th</sup> March 1824 and baptised on the 20<sup>th</sup> same month and registered in the City of Sission

Brooks also their second son William GILLIES was born on the 30<sup>th</sup> September 1825 and baptised on the 23<sup>rd</sup> and died on the 25<sup>th</sup> October 1825 and had five daughters namely Janet, Hellen, Elizabeth Margaret and Isabela. Their oldest son Robert Halliwall GILLIES was married

John Samuel GILLIES was born 09 September 1859 at Edinburgh Trinity College and lived at the Carrubbers Close Mission, 65 High Street Edinburgh Midlothian Scotland (Reference Scotland registration 941 V2), to Robert Halliwall GILLIES (Tailor & Green grocer) born Edinburgh St Andrews. John Samuel GILLIES married Helen Sandy PURVES (1860-1922) in 1883 in Edinburgh Scotland. Emigrated to New York in 1887 then moved to Pittsburgh PA, and finally settled in Magnolia St, Kearny, Hudson County, New Jersey, then North Arlington, NJ. John Samuel GILLIES and Helen Purves GILLIES had 4 children.
