The family history of William Robert RYMAN and Emma GOODWIN

William Robert RYMAN junior was born about 04 August 1827 in Lechlade Gloucestershire England. William junior's parents were William Robert RYMAN and Mary formerly GEARING (born Lechlade Gloucester) whom after the death of her husband married Isaac MATHEWS. According to William junior's marriage registration his father's occupation was Coal Merchant.

Fairford, Lechlade and Neighbourhoods

Lechlade, or Lechlade (so called from the river Leach emptying itself in to the Isis on the south side of the town; lade being an old Saxon word, signifying to throw out or empty), is in the same hundred as Fairford, about four miles from that town. This small market-town is situated near the point where the countries of Wilts, Bucks and Gloucester unite; it is neat and well built formed principally of one long and wide street. The church is a material ornament to the town, being a beautiful structure, of the style of architecture prevalent in the reign of Henry VII.; it is adorned with a noble spire, which for symmetrical proportion may vie with any in the country. The living is a rectory, of which the Rev. Leigh Bennett is the patron and incumbent. George Milward, Esq. is lord of the manor, and holds court leet triennially, when a constable and tything-man are appointed. The market-day, which is now little noticed as such is Friday; and a fair is held annually on the 9th of September. The amount of the population of the parish, in 1821, was 1,154. Post Office, Lechlade, William Hall, Post Master, - Letters from London, & c. arrive every morning at five, and are despatched every night at ten, - Letters from Stroud arrive every night at ten, and are despatched every morning at five.

Faringdon – with the villages of Buckland, Coleshill and Neighbourhoods.

Faringdon, a neat market-town, giving name to the hundred in which it lies, is 70 miles from London, 17 from Oxford, 14 from Abingdon, and 9 from Wantage: it is delightfully situated on an eminence gently rising, and in the fertile vale of Berks, or White-horse; rather more than two miles from the Isis, afterwards called the Thames. The thoroughfare of this town is very considerable, as it stands at the crossing of the two great roads, the one leading from Oxford, Abingdon, &c. to Cirencester, Gloucester, and South Wales, also the Bath and Bristol; the other from Marlborough, Salisbury, and the southern countries. The continual influx and reflux of travellers, with its extensive corn market, and cattle fairs, combine in promoting its prosperity in the absence of manufacturing establishments. Faringdon was anciently a seat of government of the Saxon kings. In the reign of King Stephen, Robert Earl of Gloucester built a strong castle here, which was afterwards besieged and razed to the ground by Stephen; and its site granted by Kin John to build Beaulieu abbey, which, after having undergone a variety of changes in its possessors, is now the property of a private gentleman. Faringdon is governed by a bailiff and constables, appointed at a court-baron, held once a year under William Bennett; Esq. The lord of the manor.

The parish church has been a handsome structure, its architecture is a mixture of the Gothic and Saxon styles, and its form crucifix. It has suffered severely, both by the hand of time and sacrilegious violence, and was deprived of its spire in the civil wars. The edifice contains several monuments of great antiquity and interest. The living is a vicarage in the gift of the lord of the manor; the present vicar is the Rev. H.H. Hawkins, whose curate is the Rev. J. Pridham. The independents, Baptists, and Quakers have each a meeting-house, and there are two schools supported by voluntary contributions. In the immediate vicinity of the town is Faringdon hill, a beautiful acclivity, terminated by a small grove, forming a kind of landmark for the surrounding countries. From hence is commanded a rich and extensive view over parts of Oxfordshire, Gloucestershire, and Wiltshire, in addition to the whole of the lovely and interesting vale beneath. The market day is Tuesday; and the fairs are, February 13th and Whit Tuesday for Horses and fat cattle; the Tuesdays before and after Old Michaelmas day (statutes), and October 29th for horses, cattle, and a large show of pigs. The parish of Faringdon contained, by the census of 1821, 2,271 inhabitants, and the township of Little Coxwell 271 persons, not included in the returns for Faringdon.

Post Office, Market-place, Thomas Belcher, Post Master. - Letters arrive from London, &c. every morning at twenty minutes after four, and are despatched every night at forty minutes past ten.- Letters from the west arrive every night at forty minutes past ten, and are despatched every morning at twenty minutes past four.- Letters from Highworth arrive at forty minutes past eight in the evening, and are despatched at six in the morning in summer, and seven in the winter.-

Office hours: the office opens at seven in the morning in summer, and eight in the winter, and closes at nine at night; but letters are taken in until ten, by paying one penny with each.

Cause of death was recorded as Uterine Tumour 7 years and Peritonitis 14 days as certified by FC Spackman M.R.C.S. William Noud was the registrar.
