Co. Theophilus & Jane took up one of the first Crown Grants of land at Omata Taranaki 1858. When the NZ Wars began he moved his family to New Plymouth & became assistant to the Treasurer of the Taranaki Provincial Council. He later filled the position of Treasurer. Jane SHAW helped found the first hospital in New Plymouth. She was a sister of John SHAW with whom her husband shared his farm. John SHAW married Olivia WAKEFIELD & Henrietta BUTTERFIELD.
