The MURLEY's were an identity in Poplar which was a shipbuilding area in England. William Walker MURLEY worked for "Money" Wigram at his yards as a shipbuilder. Prior to Wigram yards the Blackwell Shipyards were there. The East India Docks were very large and dealt mainly with spices etc from the Indies.

Further down the river a cousin Mary Jane DITTON formerly MURLEY owned a Pub called the "Windsor Castle" in Canning Town.

William and Rebecca's son William Joseph MURLEY was not recorded on the 1861 English census. I believe he left England for New Zealand between 1859 & 1861 as he married Mary BAIN 26 March 1861 in Dunedin New Zealand

William and Rebecca must have sent letters to their son William Joseph in New Zealand as on 08 & 15 October 1859 the Otago Witness newspaper listed unclaimed letters for W J MURLEY.

When the MURLEY family arrived in Dunedin it was very primitive compared to Polar in England. William owned a stationery and confectionery shop in George Street Dunedin. His son William Joseph MURLEY worked in Dunedin as a Shipwright (lighter builder) and lived in Upper Harbour.

When Dunedin channel was dredged in 1867 it allowed ships up the Harbour to the City and the lighters were no longer needed to ferry the goods to and from the emigrant ships. In 1868 the family moved to Timaru and dwelled in first in lower Arthur Street and later Bank Street. Peter and his brother Alexander BELL also settled in Timaru.

When Rebecca MURLEY was aged about 60 she took to her bed even though nothing was found to be wrong with her. Perhaps it could have been depression bought on by the death of her husband.

MURLEY & OLIVE family tale handed down

Elizabeth Sarah BELL formerly MURLEY claimed William Holman HUNT the Pre-Raphaelite (19th century) artist was a Murley/Olive cousin. The sculpture and engraver, Anthony CARDON was also a cousin and there is an engraving of his held by a descendant. It was an engraving of a painting by an artist W Ledder DELT. He engraved three of the "Cres of London" from 1794-1796 taking over from Francis WHEATLEY. There is another engraving of his, which is of a Willow Pattern Bowls and Plates. This was lent by E S BELL of 12 Trafalgar Street to the Christchurch Exhibition at the same time as Hunt's "The Light of the World" was exhibited. (Paintings of Christ in the front of some Bibles.) Anthony (Antoine) CARDON was born in Brussels in 1772 and came to London in 1792 so he must have married a relative. A Maggie CARDON was Elizabeth Murley/Bell's cousin. Holman HUNT likewise must have been a relative by marriage as his father was William HUNT who married Sarah HOBMAN. William HOBMAN was born in Cheapside London in 1827 as William Hobson HUNT, which he changed to HOLMAN. He had four sisters, Elizabeth, Maria, Sarah and Emily and one brother Edward. He married first Fanny WAUGH who died giving birth to their son Cyril and second to her sister Edith. Evelyn WAUGH the writer was the grandson of their brother.

1905 Rebecca MURLEY Arthur Street Timaru New Zealand

Rebecca MURLEY died on 20 August 1905 in Timaru Borough New Zealand. Her death registration recorded aged 91 years occupation widow. She was born in Blackwell London England and had dwelled in New Zealand for 43 years. Her parents were recorded as Elizabeth formerly CLARK and Joseph OLIVE occupation Lighterman. She was aged 21 years when she married William Walker MURLEY in England. Her living issue were recorded as 1 son aged 69 years and 2 daughters aged 68 and 58 years. Cause of death was Bronchitis and Casphyria 2 weeks as certified by Dr W W Wrydons who say her last on 15th August 1905. She was buried on 22 August at Timaru Cemetery. The Wesleyan Minister Rev S J Serpell took the service. The undertaker of Timaru John RADCLIFFE registered the death on 1st September 1905.

Mary MURLEY formerly BAIN aged 54 years died 16 November 1892 at Graham Street Dunedin. She was born in Renfrewshire Scotland and had dwelled in New Zealand for 31 years making her arrival in New Zealand around 1861. Mary's father was recorded a Duncan BAIN but there was no information regarding her mother. Cause of death was Gall Stones 17 year's obstruction of bile duct 6 weeks as certified by Dr D COLQUHOUN. Mary was buried on 18 November 1892 at the Northern Cemetery Dunedin by minister A BEUNTON. The registration stated that she married William Joseph MURLEY in Dunedin Otago and that there were 2 living males age 29 and 25 years. Hugh Gourley the Undertaker of Dunedin registered the death on 19 November 1892.

<p>I am trying to find out the dates my great grandparents arrived in Dunedin. Mr great grandmother was a widow named Jamieson from Stirling Scotland. We know she was a mid wife with two small boys, Peter & Alex. She used to row around the Bays in Dunedin, delivering babies. I think her Christian name was Elizabeth. 1) One story I heard was that they landed in Nelson first but were frightened by an earthquake & moved to Dunedin. I doubt the story. We know she remarried a man named BELL had three more children before emigrating to Canada where she was the first woman to walk the trail from Cowiechar to Dunear's BC.</p> <p>The other grandparents William & Rebecca MURLEY arrived on the ship Sarah M, also in Dunedin, with a son, name unknown, another daughter name unknown, & my grandmother Elizabeth age fifteen. William MURLEY & the son were shipwrights they later moved to Timaru where they made lighters for immigrant ships. I have a Victorian letter writer inscribed E. Murley, Blackwall, Upper Harbour, Otago. The letter examples are dates 185-, I think it could be about 1856 as my grandmother was either 83 or 84 when she died in 1928 or 9. The Murley family came from London.</p> <p>Could you please advise me as whether the General Registry Office Kingsway London would have Rebecca MURLEY (nee OLIVE's) birth recorded she was born 13 may 1814. I seem to remember reading that Somerset house records only went back to 1830? I would like to know if possible whether East India Company records are kept also Naval records, as Rebecca MURLEY's father was a Captain in the East India Company & was on the HMS Minotaur during the Battle of the Nile in 1798.
