# The family history of Alice BOYLE and Francis William CONWAY

Alice BOYLE, the first child, a daughter to Ellen nee COYLE and Edward BOYLE was born on 13 October 1872 at Onehunga, Auckland. James MACDONALD, the Roman Catholic Rector of Drury, registered the birth on 10 December 1872. He recorded Alice's father's occupation as Settler.

Alice BOYLE was 8 years old when her mother Ellen BOYLE nee COYLE died in 1880.

Alice BOYLE was living in Whitianga around 1893.

Alice BOYLE aged 22 years born NZ residence Mercury Bay occupation service was admitted on 5 March 1895 to Auckland Hospital for burned foot. She was discharged on 16 March 1895.

William was born in 1863 Auckland and his parents were Catherine nee BRENNAN and William CONWAY. Both parents were descendants of Fencible soldiers.

Alice BOYLE, occupation Domestic Duties, aged 28 years, married William CONWAY, occupation Mill Hand, aged 36 years, on the 16 September 1897 at the dwelling house of William CONWAY, Whitianga. The witnesses were Michael O'CONNOR occupation Miner, of Kauotunu, and Margaret Jane MADILL, occupation domestic duties, of Whitianga. Rev Michael EGAN married the couple.

The 1897 Intention to Marry application recorded Alice BOYLE aged 24 years had resided in Whitianga for 4 years and William CONWAY aged 30 years has resided on Whitianga for 9 years.

Alice age 26 years, and William, aged 33 years, only child, a son, Brennan CONWAY, was born on 31 July 1898 at Whitianga. William CONWAY, father of the child, of Whitianga, registered the birth on 3 September 1898.

William CONWAY, registered Francis William CONWAY, died on 18 January 1953 at his residence 36 Findlay Street, Ellerslie and was buried on 20 January at the Otahuhu Lawn Cemetery.

The New Zealand Herald Death Notice column dated Monday 19 January 1953 reads:

CONWAY Francis William on January 18 1953 at his residence 36 Findlay Street, Ellerslie beloved husband of Alice CONWAY and loved father of Brennan aged 88 years R.I.P. Requiem mass will be celebrated at the Church of Immaculate Conception Ellerslie at 9.00am tomorrow (Tuesday) prior to interment at Otahuhu Lawn Cemetery Rosary at the church at 7.30pm this (Monday) evening.

Alice CONWAY nee BOYLE, a widow, aged 80 years died exactly one month after her husband on the 18 February 1953, in their family home, 36 Findlay Street, Ellerslie, Auckland. Cause of death was recorded as Valvular disease of the heart and rheumatic arteriosclerosis. Alice was buried on 20 February alongside her husband at Otahuhu Cemetery, Auckland. The Roman Catholic minister S CONWAY, took the service. (Reference RGO NZ death registration 1953 folio 96 Auckland district)

The New Zealand Herald Death Notice column dated Thursday 19 February 1953 reads:

CONWAY Alice - On 18 February 1953 at her residence, 36 Findlay Street, Ellerslie dearly beloved wife of the late Frances William CONWAY, beloved mother of Brennan and loved sister of Nellie (Mrs MURRAY) aged 80 years. R.I.P. Requiem Mass will be celebrated at the Church of the Immaculate Conception, Ellerslie at 9am tomorrow (Friday) prior to interment at Otahuhu Lawn Cemetery. Rosary at Church at 7.30pm this (Thursday) evening. No Flowers by request.
