The family history of Ellen BOYLE & Mary Anne BOYLE & Thomas BOYLE

Three of Edward and Ellen's children have no descendants. The twins Ellen and Mary Anne died young while their older brother Thomas BOYLE never married. This is their family history.

Ellen BOYLE

Ellen BOYLE the oldest twin was born 29 July 1874 at Papakura Auckland and was baptized in the Catholic Church Otahuhu on 2 August 1874 by the Rev M D O'Hara. The sponsors were James BOYLE of Howick and Mary COYLE of Papakura. (Reference Baptism register held at Bishop House Ponsonby Auckland)

Her life was to be very short as Ellen, age 3 months, died on the 7 October 1874 at Papakura, Auckland. Cause of death was debility. Thomas BOYLE, her grandfather, registered the death on 13 October and made his X mark. The record reads twin daughter of Edward and Ellen BOYLE of Papakura. Ellen BOYLE was buried at Papakura Cemetery, Auckland.

Mary Ann BOYLE

Mary Ann BOYLE, Ellen's younger twin sister was born 29 July 1874 at Papakura Auckland.

(Reference Baptism register held at Bishop House Ponsonby Auckland)

Her life was also very short as Mary Ann age 3 months 6 days died on the 21 October 1874 at Papakura Auckland just 14 days after her twin sister Ellen. Cause of death was debility. Thomas BOYLE her grandfather registered the death on 21 October and made his X mark. The record reads twin daughter of Edward and Ellen BOYLE of Papakura. Mary Ann BOYLE was buried at Papakura Cemetery, Auckland.

Thomas BOYLE

Thomas BOYLE the only son of Edward and Ellen was born on 28 July 1875 at Papakura. Thomas's father, Edward BOYLE, a contractor of Papakura, registered the birth on 2 August 1875.

There was a record for a Thomas Boyle of St Patrick School in Panmure. This came from an article published in the New Zealand Tablet 30 August 1889

Thomas BOYLE occupation miner of Consul/Consols Street, Waihi, enlisted in the First & Second reserves of the 1st New Zealand Expeditionary Force (1914-1918). He registered in the Hauraki district.

Edward BOYLE Waihopo poultry farmer (father of Thomas' below)

Thomas BOYLE living Waiharara (near Mangonui far North) also living there was his sister Ellen MURRAY

Thomas BOYLE never married and on 3 December 1949 he was admitted to Auckland Hospital

Thomas BOYLE died on 18 July 1950 at the Mental Hospital, Auckland, from Kaitaia. His occupation was recorded as retired miner, age 75 years, and cause of death Bronchitis Pneumonia and Myocardial degeneration. Thomas was buried on 20 July at the Waikumete Cemetery in Auckland. The Roman Catholic minister, C CURNAM, took the service.
