# The family history of James HILLS (BOYLE) and Anne MILBANK

James HILLS was the eldest son of Edward BOYLE and Hannah (Annie) HILLS nee ATKINSON. He was born about December 1881 in Awhitu, Auckland, New Zealand. His birth was not registered but was recorded in the Helensville School Register.

On the 21 November 1899 James BOYLE (HILLS) was admitted to Auckland Hospital with Influenza. It was noted that he was 17 years old born in New Zealand and residing at 17 Baker Street, Auckland. He was discharged from hospital on 28 November 1899. The register stated his religion as Church of England.

James's mother Anne HILLS appeared on the 1899 Auckland Central Electoral Roll living at Baker Street occupation Home Duties.

James HILLS, aged 24 years, occupation Milkhand, married Anne MILBANK, age 28 years, on 4 December 1906. The Church of England minister, Rev W E LUSH, married the couple in the Church of Epiphany, Newton, Auckland. The witnesses were Richard MILBANK, a builder of Arch Hill, and Samuel MILBANK, a bootmaker of Arch Hill, Auckland. Richard was the bride's father.

HILLS - On January 20 1948, at 5 Edgars Road, Grey Lynn, Anne, beloved wife of James HILLS, and mother of Allan and Stanley. A service will be held at the above address at 1.45 p.m. to-day (Thursday), the funeral leaving at 2 p.m. for the Crematorium Waikumete.

HILLS - On January 20, at 5 Edgar's Road Grey Lynn, Annie dearly-loved wife of James HILLS, beloved mother of Allan and Stanley and dear nana of Dennis, Beverly and Jimmy, Sweet be her rest.

James's youngest son, Stanley Richard HILLS, and his wife, Helena Veronica, were living at 3 Jersey Avenue, Auckland around this time. I believe James was living with his son and daughter -in-law.

James HILLS, occupation General Labourer, aged 82 years, died on the 10 December 1964 at the Cornwall Public Hospital, Epsom, from 36 Valley Road, Mt Eden, Auckland. Cause of death was Bronco Pneumonia and Heart Disease. He was cremated on 9 December at Waikumete Cemetery, Auckland. His parents were recorded as Hannah nee ATKINSON and Edward HILLS. He had no widow but living issue was recorded as 2 males age 56 and 54 years.

The Death Column of an Auckland newspaper "The New Zealand Herald" dated Saturday 13 December 1964 reads:

HILLS James - On Dec 10 1964, at Cornwall Hospital beloved husband of the late Anne, father of Allan and Stan, granddad of Dennis, Beverly, Jimmy, Linda, Helen, Michael, great-grand-dad of Selina, Teresa, Allan, Simon and Robert, in his 83rd year. A service will be held at the chapel of Tilton, Opie and Pattison Ltd, 252 Great North Rd, Grey Lynn, today (Saturday) at 3.30pm, funeral then leaving for the Waikumete Crematorium. No flowers, by request. Messages to 29 Kanuka St, Pt Chevalier.
