Mary Ellen and Ernest Carl Frederick ZUGE adopted Mary Agnes Amelia ZUGE in 1899. Agnes Mary TAYLOR was born on 2 July 1899 at Gundry Street, Auckland. Her birth mother was Helen Edith Rockfort TAYLOR who was aged 20 years at the time of birth. The birth was registered on 4 July 1899 by Agnes MCMULLAN who was present at birth.

Ernest Carl Frederick ZUGE was naturalised and signed an Oath of Allegiance on 22 August 1899 at Auckland. The Memorial states that Ernest was born in Stettire Germany. He was aged 35 years and had lived in New Zealand for 10 years. Ernest FORDS declared that he

had known E.C.F. ZUGE for 2 ½ years "I have seen him continually as a seaman on the "Akaroa" and he is a sober hardworking man".

Ernest Frederick ZUGE age 71 occupation labourer died 23 August 1935 at Auckland Infirmary Epsom from 26 Richmond Road Grey Lynn. Cause of death was senility several years myocardial degeneration sever year as certified by Dr C E Maguire who saw him last on 22 August 1935. Ernest was buried on 25 August at the Waikumete Cemetery, Auckland by Roman Catholic minister P SHERWIN. Ernest's birthplace was Germany and his parents were Frederica formerly ZARNOTTE and Godfried ZUGE occupation farmer. He was age 31 when he married Mary Ellen BOYLE in Auckland and his living issue was recorded as 1 female aged 36 years. J Fraser undertaker of Auckland registered the death on 26 August 1935.

Mary Ellen ZUGE formerly BOYLE aged 69 years widow died 27 October 1942 at St Joseph's Home in Ponsonby from 19 Richmond Road Ponsonby Auckland. Cause of death was recorded as myocardial degeneration 6 months senility as certified by Dr E L Fitzgerald who saw her last on 20 October 1942. She was born in Panmure and her parents were recorded as Jane formerly FAHEY and James BOYLE occupation Engineer. Mary was buried on 28 October at Waikumete Cemetery by Roman Catholic minister, J MANSFIELD. She married age 22 to Ernest Carl Frederick ZUGE and her living issue was recorded as 1 female age 43 years. A W Good undertaker of Auckland registered the death on 02 November 1942
