Michael Fahy [sic] BOYLE was born on 31 May 1878 at Papakura, Auckland New Zealand. His parents were Jane formerly FAHY age 25 years born Panmure Auckland and James BOYLE age 38 years born Tipperary Ireland. His parents married 04th July 1871 at Panmure Auckland. James BOYLE father of Papakura, registered the birth on 3 June 1878. The registrar was H de Martellin

Mabel's parents were married in September 1881 in Auckland. James PEARCE the father from Ireland Street registered the birth on 1 May 1866. The registrar was J Owen Lord.

Police Court News - A Threatened Wife - Buying a Revolver - A powerfully built young labouring man named Michael Fahey Boyle, was brought before Mr C C Cutten SM, yesterday morning to answer a charge of having threatened his wife Mabel Ann Boyle with grievous bodily harm. He pleaded not guilty and was defended by Mr Alan Moody. The wife's story was that her husband did not want to live with her, he only wanted the custody of the two little girls. On the 14th instant he purchased a knife and threatened to cut her throat. She called a witness who said defendant had shown her a revolver and cartridges and told her he proposed to shoot his wife and also a man named Tom Johnson. Defendant said in evidence that he had threatened his wife because of her saying that she was going to a dance which he did not wish her to attend. But his only desire was to frighten her. It was true he had purchased a revolver last Saturday morning but it was not with the intention of shooting either his wife or Johnson. He had been working as a Bushman some years ago for a man named Ohlsen and they met on Saturday morning when Ohlsen offered him work at Opotiki which he accepted. Ohlsen then said there were plenty of wild pigs up there, and added that if defendant was as good a revolver shot as he used to be, he ought to have good sport. Thereupon Boyle went and purchased a revolver and cartridges, which he handed to his sister, asking her to keep them for him until after Christmas, when he proposed to join Ohlsen. His Worship found that defendant must be convicted, and ordered him to find two sureties in £25 each to keep the peace for 12 months towards his wife.

A Brave Effort - (By Telegraph - Special Correspondence) Auckland 02 February - The Dargaville correspondent of the Herald reports that a case of conspicuous bravery occurred in connection with the drowning of Albert Wyatt. When the deceased fell off the wharf, a spectator named Michael Boyle, without divesting himself of any garments, jumped into the strong tide to affect a rescue. He dived and

managed, to grasp Wyatt by the hair, and swam for a wharf pile 6 feet distant. As he reached the pile deceased slipped from his fingers, and disappeared. Boyle then undressed and, assisted by two other men, dived repeatedly but was unable to locate the body which was discovered eight days later in the Awakino Creek, nine miles away from where the accident occurred.

Cause of death was syncope ½hour, cerebral abscess (left front lobe) 2 weeks Intra cranial suppuration Intra nasal suppuration as certified by Dr D R Abernethy who saw him last on 25 May 1931. Michael was born Papakua Auckland and his parents were Mary and James Boyle occupation Labourer. Hel was buried on 28 March 1931 Waikumete cemetery Auckland in Soldier Block Plot No-C-2-44 by Roman Catholic Minister, E JOYCE. Michael was age 28 when he married Mabel PEARCE in Auckland. His widow was age 45 and their living issue were 2 males

age 21 & 25 and 1 female age 17 years. E G Scrimshaw the undertaker of Hamilton registered the death on 01 June 1931.
