Thomas Charles BOYLE was born on 16 May 1877 at Napier. Details of the father were recorded as Thomas BOYLE, a Labourer age 34 years, born Auckland, New Zealand. Mother's details were Georgina BOYLE formerly MILES, age 25 years, born London, England. The details of his parent's marriage were recorded as 31 May 1876 at Te Aute, Hawkes Bay. Georgina BOYLE, the mother, of Napier, registered the birth on 09 June 1871

Thomas Charles was aged 1 year when his mother Georgina BOYLE died on the 09 July 1878 in Waipawa.

Thomas Charles BOYLE enlisted in the New Zealand 7th contingent and fought in the (Boer War) South African War. He was attested at Wellington on 25 February 1901 aged 21 years 2 months, and was discharged in Wellington on 15 September 1902, age 23 years. He served overseas for 1 year 87 days. His attestation form recorded his religion

as Roman Catholic and next-of-kin as Mr Thomas BOYLE (father) address Hastings, Hawkes Bay. He was awarded with the South African Medal and clasps Transvaal, Orange Free State. His description on discharge was recorded as:

Age: 23 years Height: 5 feet 10½ inches Complexion: Fair Eyes: Grey Hair: Red Trade: Labourer

Intended place of residence: Hastings, Hawkes Bay

Cemetery by Church of England minister G Y Woodward. Cause of death was Cerebral haemorrhage Hyperprisis as certified by Dr C King who saw her last on 9 February 1939.
