I devise the house next to the stables in Cambridge Terrace to my son Thomas for his life he paying all outgoings and after his death for my said two daughters Eliza and Isabella as tenants in common in equal shares. I devise my house next to last mentioned house to my son Walter for his life he paying all outgoings and after his death to my said two daughters Eliza and Isabella as tenants in common in equal shares. I devise my house in Lorne Street nearest to the stables being number 46 to my son Thomas for his life and after his death to my said two daughters Eliza and Isabella as tenants in common in equal shares The adjoining house being number 45 I devise to my daughter Eliza for her life she paying all outgoings and after her death to her children in equal shares and if there should be one such child then Upon Trust for such child. My other two houses in Lorne Street being number 44 and 44a I devise to my said Eliza for her life she paying all outgoings and after her death for her children in equal shares and if there shall be only one such child then Upon Trust for such child. I direct to be divided equally among my children I direct that in this will the word children or child if not inconsistent with the context including my grandson Walter Alexander.
