Hazelwood's Store & Father Christmas

Over the years Upper Hutt children will remember their visit to see Father Christmas at the former Hazelwood's Department Store. A special man Leonard George Rink in 1970 was recorded as being Santa for the Hazelwood's Department Store role from 1946 to 1972.

At Christmas time we often remember people and places from our past just like Leonard George Rink and the Hazelwood's Department Store.

Hazelwood's first store was established in 1893 [some records state 1887] by James Alfred (Jimmy) Hazelwood. Jimmy was the Managing Director of Hazelwood's up to 1944. In 1944 Theodore Nesbit Gibbs purchased the store from J Benge and J A Hazelwood. In 1954 Theodore's son Colin Gibbs became the Assistant Manager then took over as Manager in 1956. The original Hazelwood's Store was rebuilt several times over the years.

James Alfred (Jimmy) Hazelwood was born 1875 in New Zealand. In 1897 in New Zealand Jimmy married Margaret Ada Bennett (born NZ 1878) and they had five children. The children were [1] Ethel May born 1898, [2] James Thomas born 1901, [3] Myrtle born 1903, [4] Hector Gilbert born 1909 and [5] Wilson Alfred born 1912 all in Upper Hutt. Margaret Ada Hazelwood died 23 November 1951 and was buried at Akatarawa cemetery. James Alfred Hazelwood died 24 December 1968 and was buried with his wife at Akatarawa cemetery Upper Hutt.

71th Anniversary

In 1964 the Hazelwood's Store celebrated its 71st anniversary and the opening of their new building. Although this building still stands the Store is just a memory.

Upper Hutt is today a city with a tremendous future. Our new building and improved services will help to make this future more certain. We will officially open our new building on Wednesday 14th October and at the same time celebrate our 71st anniversary. We invite you to some and use these new services."

The Mayor Mr Percy Kinsman offered greetings and congratulations and spoke very warmly of the founder Mr J A Hazelwood who was present with his daughter Mrs Hector Poulson.

Leonard George (Len) Rink

Leonard George Rink was born 05 November 1906 in New Zealand. In 1928 Len married Mavis Edith Marita Kitney (1910-2011) in New Zealand. Len and Mavis resided in Whiteman's Valley Road with their children. In November 1961 Corporal L G Rink of the Royal NZ Electrical and Mechanical Engineers was presented at a ceremonial parade in Trentham Camp with his Long service and good conduct medal. Len died 21 December 1977 in New Zealand.

Len was involved with numerous local organisation and charities. He was very popular at Christmas time with local children.

Although 'Old Man Weather' was not too kind on Friday afternoon last when Father Xmas arrived at Hazelwood's Magic Cave, it did not deter the children any, as they were there in hundreds to meet him. Throughout Friday afternoon and evening there was a stream of children and parents visiting the Cave. The Cave itself is very prettily decorated with coloured lights, fancy papers and balloons. As you walk in you see a nice rockery with real plants, also goldfish swimming around in a large bowl. An electric train is yet another novelty for the children as it goes round and round. Each person receives a present from Father Xmas or his fairies and the secrets that are whispered into the children's ear is something we have not yet fathomed. Hazelwood's are to be congratulated for re-introducing this novel Christmas treat, as it saves the parents having to take their children to the city.

Inside the cave is a brilliant blaze of colour. Fairy lights hang from the roof, greenery lines the wall and o one corner all the story book characters are waiting to greet those who call on Santa. Donald Duck and his cousins, the Seven Dwarfs, Jiminy Cricket and Pinocchio. Mickey and Minnie Mouse, Gus the Mouse, the Perky Penguin and Three Little Pigs are all there to gladden children's hearts. An electric train rushes through Toy Town and the residents are enjoying life on a Big Wheel. Father Christmas sites in a place of honour and after receiving his youthful guests his two fairies hand out presents to all his visitors.

Children who have not yet been to see Santa should not miss, as a visit to his Magic Cave is a trilling adventure.

The six clowns, the like o which has never been seen in Upper Hutt before with their enormous heads, kept the children amused, or at least most of them, (some of the tiny tots being a little afraid of them). After talking to the children, Father Christmas, led by Mr C Gibbs entered his magic cave with his fairies where he immediately began to take orders from the kiddies for their stockings. Just outside the cave there is a miniature railway working for children to have rides and this was taken advantage of by many. Yes you can hand it to Mr Colin Gibbs, and his executive staff who organised the great show for Upper Hutt, the first if its kind. To the children in the Upper Valley Mr Len Rink is perhaps the most famous Father Christmas of all, for he has the unique experience of acting in this capacity in the one store for the past 14 years which could possible the New Zealand record. His delightful personality and obvious enjoyment have made him a much loved figure in the community both to children and parents alike. Mr Rink recalls holding his first Christmas cave in Hazelwood Hardware Reserve about 14 years ago and has many happy and humorous memories of his long service. Some of the earlier children have returned with their own children. In recent years the number of children to pass through his cave would be in the vicinity of 33,000. One of the objects of the cave is to provide entertainment and interest to the children and this has been done in the way of exhibiting birds, fish, etc., and most important of all the electric train. It just would not be Father Christmas Cave without the electric train, which was set up the very first year of the cave. These various displays have captured the imagination of the children and the remarks of parents have made past efforts well worthwhile.
