To son Charles FOLLETT land containing 45 acres bought from Thomas WALKER and twenty acres adjoining brought from James BULL. Land surveyed into town sections and paddock about 30 acres said section 17 on road to Wanganui to be sold to pay debts then balance to wife Sarah FOLLETT. The remainder of the property, to his 3 sons James, William and Charles FOLLETT upon attaining the age of 21 years or to their sons. Charles appoints Arthur William FOLLETT Halcombe Rangitikei and Frederick BEAVEN of Marton his executors. I bequeath to my daughter Eliza FOLLETT my trap horse and harness for her own use and I bequeath to my sons and daughters John FOLLETT, William FOLLETT, Mary Ann MARR, Eliza FOLLETT and Sarah Jane FOLLETT the whole of the remainder of my personal property together with the money now in the bank of New Zealand at Marton aforesaid to be equally divided between them a share and share alike such divisions to take place as soon as consonantly may be after my death. I hereby appoint Arthur William FOLLETT Walcolmbe of Fielding esquire and Frederick BEABEN of Marton Merchant Executors of this my Will and revoke all former or other will by me at anytime here to for made I do declare this to be my last will and Testament. On witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this Twentieth day of December one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight. Signed Sarah her X mark FOLLETT

Follett Street - Named after <u>Charles FOLLETT</u>, another of the early land-owners, with property from Follett Street to High Street, which he farmed for years, until it was sold in the great subdivision explosion of 1866. A son, <u>John FOLLETT</u>, had a shoemaking shop on the Follett Street Broadway corner, now occupied by McDonald Building (Reference Marton public library 1988 publication Tales of the Rangitikei by Paul Melody page 142)

Signal Street = After Robert SIGNAL, the very first owner of land in Central Marton. He arrived in 1858 and farmed the area, but eventually sold parcels of land to <u>Charles FOLLETT</u> and Thomas and Richard MORRIS. All four subdivided their properties and sold sections to prospective settlers in 1866, forming the basis of the Township. (Reference Marton public library 1988 publication Tales of the Rangitikei by Paul Melody page 141)

People have been living at Tutaenui since before 150. One of the earliest was Robert Signal, an 1858 arrival, who had subsequently sold some of his land to other settlers, Richard Morris and <u>James Follett</u>, and it was to these men that the land-seekers went with their request for land to set up a township.
