Passengers Descriptions Of The Accident - Marvellous Escapes - A Carriage Turns A Somersault - The passengers who were delayed by the accident were brought into town at 10 minutes to 3 this afternoon by the special sent out to their assistance. From all accounts the mishap was of a most serious character, and it is little short of marvellous that there were no fatalities, and that so few injuries were received among the 30 or 40 passengers who were on board the train. The train altogether comprised an engine, three passenger carriages, a guard's van, and a horse-box, the latter being coupled next the engine. The engine and horse-box alone did not leave the track, the whole of the tail of the train pitching down the embankment. The derailment appears to have occurred in this way. A gang of platelayers were employed in doing something to the track, and about 30ft of line was apparently only temporarily fastened down, and when the engine shot on to it, just after coming round a curve, and at a speed of about 25 miles an hour, the rails, to use a railway expression, spread. As soon as the carriages came on to the loosened rail they became derailed, and after running along the sleepers for a short distance toppled over the side of the embankment, which at this spot is of considerable depth. The quard's van, being weighty, did not fall very far, but the passenger carriages rolled down for some distance, one of them perhaps 20ft or 30ft, and hung there in a loop between the engine and the guard's van, the couplings remaining fast. One of the, carriages of the bird cage pattern is said to have turned a complete somersault, and in its fall was badly wrecked, the roof coming off. In this carriage there were about eight passengers - Dr Findlay and Mr &m, a woman and her husband, and two or three children. When the vehicle turned turtle, they were all thrown together, higgledy-piggled, and battered against the sides and roof of the vehicle. windows were shattered, and as before stated the roof was wrenched off, through which the unfortunate passengers crept when the carriage came to a standstill.

Amongst the passengers were: - Dr Tindlay, and Mr Sim (of the firm of Stout, Mondy, Sim, and Pindlay) Mrs David Bruce, of Rakaia, who was coming from Masterton, Mr Thomas Kempton, of Greytown, and his daughter, who were on their way to join the Penguin for the South, Mrs Ingley and son the Rev. A O Williams, of Wanganui, Mr John Fabian, jun., of Greytown, and about 20 others, including a number of children. The passengers were brought on to the Kaitoke Station on trollies. All their luggage was left behind, but will be brought into town early to-night. Mr Fabian had a most miraculous escape. As the carriage in which he was seated was going off the line he jumped out and landed under a bush. As he alighted another of the carriages was thrown off the line and went clean over him, without touching him anywhere. As the result of his fall he has sustained a nasty bruise in the region of the left eye. Like the other passengers he was severely shaken, but has come into town little the worse for his startling experience. The passenger who sustained the greatest injury was in the bird-cage carriage with her husband, said to be a railway employee. She has dislocated her shoulder and is terribly bruised and shaken.

Elizabeth Kempton nee Hodder 1839 – 1907 Elm Grove Kempton's Line Greytown

As I look over the landscape from our balcony the majestic weeping elm dominating the view and giving a sense of timelessness to our moments her on earth. I fall to wondering about the lives, loves joys and sorrows of those who have lived her before. Taken from "A House at Sunrise" by Margaret Kempton.

My great grandmother—in-law Elizabeth Kempton (nee Hodder) married Thomas Kempton jnr. In 1857 aged 18 and was the cofounder of Elm Grove homestead and farm on Kempton's Line. She and Thomas had 13 children and also brought up 3 grandchildren. There were two live-in maids to help Elizabeth with house and family duties. I can only surmise that she was kept very busy over-seeing family meals washing and child care being pregnant herself every year from 1858 to 1864 then every second year from 1866 to 1877 her last child being born in 1882 the same year as her first grandchild when she was 43.

There was a huge wooden table when I first came to 'Elm Grove' in 1968 and it would have been around this that the family congregated. An orchard next to the house grew apples plums pears peaches apricots figs walnuts and cherries so I presume much time was spent preserving these and making wine and apple cider. Butter was made here as well as bread in the huge bricked bakers oven. Farm grown and killed meat along with vegetables from Thomas's well socked vegetable garden would have made the homestead pretty much self sufficient foodwise. The Kemptons would have taken their white horse and phaeton to visit friends or go into Greytown shops. Goods would be delivered a Greytown seamstress sewed their gowns hawkers visited to sell their wares and swaggers were frequent callers who received food from the kitchen and slept in the shelter of the manuka opposite the homestead.

Elizabeth would have attended NZ's first Arbor Day in 1890 along with members of her family. A visit to the Morrisons at Morrisons Bush would again have been an occasion to take out the phaeton. A truly cherished item at Elm Grove is a sampler sewn by Elizabeth in 1849 when she was eight years old. This was given to me by a descendant of her eldest daughter Mary Ann on the occasion of the Kempton Reunion held in Greytown in 1986.

The first tree was cut down by Mr Thomas Kempton from land leased by Messrs McClaggan and Thompson, in Morison's Bush, Greytown, from which bush a great deal of the rest of the timber came. It was cut by Mr Donald, of Featherston, and Mr Hastwell was the contractor to deliver the timber to Messrs McClaggan and Thompson, the wharf contractors, Wellington. Mr Thomas Ray, who is now alive at Carterton, had the honour of carting the first load over the hill. The other carters, many of whom are still living in the Wairarapa, include Messrs Salisbury and Cookery. In conclusion I may state that we found some difficulty in getting the full lengths of wood from Morison's Bush, so we got the remaining portions from Messrs Barton's and Collins' estates, both situated on the Hutt river. The wharf was first called the "Public Wharf," but Mr Thomas W. McKenzie was

instrumental in having the name changed to the Queen's, under which distinction it still stands.

In Bankruptcy – The meeting of creditors in the bankrupt estate of Arthur Alexander Mitchell farmer of Foxton did not take place Monday afternoon owing to none of the creditors putting in an appearance. Debtor was, however, examined by Mr G S Scott (D.0.A.), and in answer to questions, said, the immediate cause of his seeking the protection of the Bankruptcy Court was through McMillan, Rhodes & Co obtaining judgment against him for £64, and issuing a distress warrant. The bailiff served the warrant but did not seize. Promised not to reserve anything. The assets mentioned in the schedule were all he possessed. He came up to Palmerston and consulted Messrs Baker and Cooke, who advised him to file. McMillan, Rhodes and Co had refused to accept his assets. Had paid Messrs Baker and Cooke £9. Am living on 90 acres of land, which belonged to his father. Did not pay rent. Had not worked the land, as debtor had been carting and cutting flax by contract. Had always been paid for work he had performed. The contracts did not pay owing to debtor having taken them in the winter. Had lost time through wet weather, and stopping work to repair the tramway. Debtor did not own horses and drays, but used to hire them for his contracts. About 18 months ago witness owned 15 or 16 head of cattle, 8 horses, dray and harness. Had grazed stock for other people. Was in a solvent position at this time. Debtor's father's name was William Mitchell, and he resided in Abel Smithstreet, Wellington. Am a married man with three children under 6 years of age. If allowed a month or six weeks could pay his creditor's 10s in the on the approved claim in the bankruptcy. The following is the statement of assets and liabilities Liabilities Foxton McMillan, Rhodes & Co., £64 Is 8d J. Walls, £3 8s T. Proctor, £2 15s T. Newth, £3 5s Shannon: J. Powell, £15 Christchurch J. B. Craig, £3 8s total, £91 18s 8d. Assets Stock-in trade at Foxton consisting of one cart and harness (£22 10s), 3 cows, (£l5), 3 calves, (£2), 1 pig, (£2), dairy utensils, (£1) furniture, £10. Total £51 5s, Deficiency, £40 13s 8d. The meeting adjourned until this afternoon. Standard.
