We learn from a Wairarapa paper that Mr Kempton, senior, a pioneer Greytown settler, left Wellington in March 1853, to settle in the Wairarapa. He and his party were accompanied by four bullocks, carrying their goods and chattels, and they managed to make Greytown after a three days journey. There was comfortable accommodation as far as the Pukuratahi, where Hodder's Golden Fleece Hotel marked the limits of civilisation. The path over the Rimutaka was a bridle track. At Featherston Burling kept an accommodation house, and the road to Greytown was a track across a stoney plain, and beyond it flax, scrub, and swamp.

"Late on Thursday after noon March 27 1853, the first of the Wairarapa Small Farm Association settlers arrived in Greytown. They were Mr Thomas Kempton his son Thomas, Mr Ben Stevens, Mr & Mrs Moles and the Rev Bruff and they tramped their weary way from the Patarutahi. Mr Kempton built a shack on the present main street line and was later joined by his wife and family. Mr Stevens settled on the west of the

main street and Mr & Mrs Moles settled on "Skull Clearing" between the present Post Office site and the northern boundry. Tracks were cut through the bush and the settlement established."

"The remaining two members of the party were father and son Thomas Kempton senior and junior. The Kempton's settled vigoursley to a variety of pursuits while acquiring and farming land upon which their descendants still live today.

A butcher shop, Store, Carrying business, Sawmill, interest and the "Raising Sun" hotel are some of those known. Upon the arrival of the party according to family tradition Thomas senior is said to have said to his son "Well Tom I think this is the place. Why don't you take the shovel and turn the first sod. In 1856 he secured a further place in History when he drove a specially constructed narrow bullock wagon containing a ton of goods from Wellington to Greytown to open the Rimutaka Hill road to wheeled traffic on Tuesday June 10. In public life Thomas senior became chairman of the Greytown Town board in 1876 and first mayor upon proclamation of the borough in 1878. Thomas Junior sat on the first borough council."

It was March 1854 that Thomas Kempton's little party of Greytown pioneers stumbled over the summit to occupy what the luck of the draw had given them. The unfinished road at least would have been familiar to Kempton who had already undertaken contract packing over the hill. As he recalled the almost heroic pilgrimage 29 years later in company with his eldest son, Thomas junior, a Mr & Mrs Moles from Tasmania, Ben Stevens and the Rev Mr Bruff, they set out from Wellington with four bullocks to carry carefully selected burdens of tools, crockery, kitchen utensils, bedding, fruit trees, shrubs and vegetable and flower seeds. At the Taita Gorge one man of the road party when told of their destination exclaimed 'What! To that forty acre swindle!'

From Jimmy Brown's at Upper Hutt the road deteriorated making hard work of their ascent of the Mangaroa Hill. The small thatched where which masqueraded as Hodder's Golden Fleece Hotel provided pretty bright comfort for their night's stay as the road workers were spending their pay. One jeered "Go on my brave pioneers and let naught prevent thy onward progress'. Long before a century had passed it was clear that Kemptons had no need of such advise but the immediate road ahead had problems. The unfurnished Rimutake track caused the bullocks to stumble and shed their loads. The crockery was broken. From Burlings they made their way across the stony Moroa Plain to acres of flax and scrub behind which was swamp. Kempton said that they arrived on the site of Greytown at 4 p.m. ion Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> March to be greeted by Corbett, who at least could point out the appropriate sections to them. The tent was pitched and pigeons for food were as plentiful as sparrows. Mrs Moles recollection of the occasion was that they spent the first night under an umbrella so perhaps the Kempton tent was a small one. Unfortunately the more important problem of the correct date assails us immediately. The 27 was a Sunday not a Thursday but allowing four days and three nights for the journey the date would be correct. Kempton recalled too that on Sunday following their arrival the Rev Bruff. Identified as one G B Brough a recent arrival from Melbourne held a service TBC
