

Huggins Private Hospital & Boarding House

Situated on part section 128 - Main Street Upper Hutt

In 1912 Mr Augustus HUGGINS began building a brick dwelling on his property in Upper Hutt. The dwelling was once situated north of Wakefield Street on Main Street on the site where the Queens Chambers (19) is now situated in central Upper Hutt.

Mrs Lydia Esther HUGGINS established a Private Hospital and later a Boarding House at the property built by her husband. They named the house “*Highbury Villa*” but some locals referred to it as Huggins Castle.

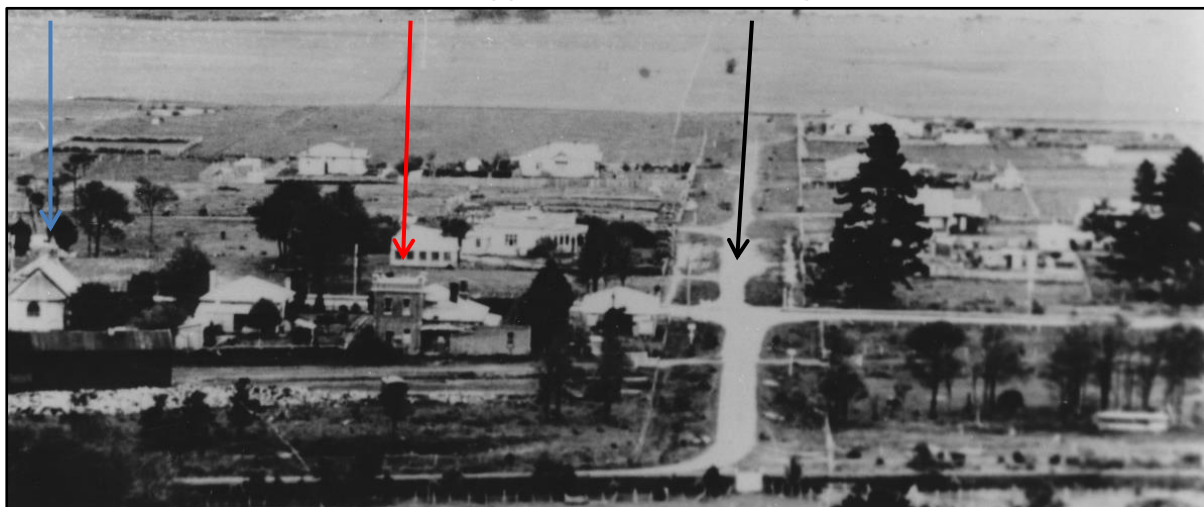

Mr Luckins has finished the house he was building for Mr Parkes in King Street, and is now at work on a house for his own use in William Street. Mr R Scholes is near completion of the Presbyterian Manse, and Messrs Huggins and Harrison are well advanced with the alterations and additions to Mr Huggins’ brick dwelling on the main road. The killed and injured - A sorry story - Well-known local residents - Personal notes

Of the six persons who succumbed as the result of the explosion, three were dead when their bodies were recovered. These were W Flynn, George Taylor, and Constable Mahoney.

The first body to be recovered was that of Flynn, who was discovered under some debris, including a sheet of corrugated iron, on the footpath in front of the store. Taylor's body was found, inside the shop, not far from the front entrance, Mr Vivian was found behind the shop counter. He was cut about the face a good deal, but was not badly burned. He was carried in an unconscious condition into the billiard-room of the Provincial Hotel, and expired an hour

later. Mr Comesky was found in an unconscious condition in Mr Edwards office (the loan to adjoining the store), where he had been engaged in dismantling a telephone instrument. Constable Mahoney's remains were the last to be found. First aid was rendered to the injured by two Sisters from St Joseph's Orphanage, Nurse Huggins, and a number of other women. Several men also assisted in this work.

Apologies were tendered on behalf of the mothers of the three girl babies – the while nine little ones who were born in the institution since it was opened less than a year ago being thus accounted for. Dr Kemo was also present and the ubiquitous photographer (in this case by request – G L Lay) took a picture of the party. By unanimous vote of the mothers it was decided that baby Wade had made the best progress for his age.

At the end of 1915 Lydia Huggins stopped advertising her Nursing Home. This would have been around the time that she began taking in boarders. Some newspapers mentioned that the Huggins Boarding house was popular with the single railway-men.

In 1918 the Influenza Epidemic made its appearance in Upper Hutt and a temporary Hospital was established at the Upper Hutt School. One volunteer was Miss Eileen May McINNES the daughter of Mrs Lydia Esther HUGGINS. During the epidemic Lydia prepared dinner for her daughter Eileen and the volunteer staff at the temporary hospital. On Thursday 21 November 1918 Miss Eileen May McInnes was sent home from the hospital with the flue and when well continued to volunteer.

The evening meal for the staff often as many as nine was prepared by Ms Huggins from 19 November to 13 December, twenty five successive nights and Miss Morpeth drove down to the school with it every night so everything got there "pie on". If "Mum" had heard what the boys and the nurses said of the tastiness of the lay out she would have felt that her efforts

were appreciated by the staff. Milk was freely supplied to Mrs Huggins by Mrs Harrison, and meat, vegetables and groceries were supplied on order. When one calls to mind that Mrs Huggins had her houseful of boarders to look after, and that her daughter Miss McInnes was laid up with the flu from 21 November when she went home from the hospital "played-out", until 29 November it can be easily understood why Old Mac classes Mrs Huggins as one of his best helpers.

Obituary - Mrs L E Huggins

On Sunday evening in St David's Presbyterian Church Upper Hutt, Rev G W Hunt made special reference to the loss St David's congregation had sustained in the passing of Mrs L Huggins, for many years an active member of St David's Church. The service was largely attended and appropriate hymns were sung. The choir rendered the anthem "What Are These That Are Arrayed in White Robes." Mrs F Benton sang as a sacred solo "Just For To-day." The preacher took his text from Matthew, 25th chapter, verses 22 and 23 "Well done, good and faithful servant; thou has been faithful over few things, I will make thee ruler over many things, Enter thou into the joy of thy Lord." In his address Mr Hunt said "In Christ's estimate of the future life it was remarked that there were two elements that were of great encouragement to believers. Many of our popular and common ideas of heaven were not those of Jesus Christ. In scores of hymns and devotional treatises there was more or less flamboyant sentiment. In the view of our Lord the world to come is a world of progress and of duty identity of character and the development of capacity. Rewards are to be conditioned, not by quantity but by quality of service. Might they not say with all sincerity of their late friend, "Well done, good and faithful servant." Looking back across the years I cannot think of a more fitting expression. If to feed the hungry, clothe the needy, visit the sick, is a badge of Christian citizenship, then our friend wears that badge to-day. From my own personal knowledge, I know of many instances of unselfish service rendered in the name of Christ to those in need. For ten years the late Mrs Huggins was secretary of St. David's Ladies Guild. In this capacity her labours were fruitful to a degree beyond her knowledge. St. David's owes much to her zeal and initiative. To be good occasionally, when the spirit moves, to work spasmodically and drop out of the race when inclination dictates, is not difficult, but to keep on keeping on in some form of Christian work and effort is a mark of goodness and fidelity which has its reward. The late Mrs Huggins will be sadly missed by a wide circle of friends and the sympathy of many goes out to those who have been bereaved.

For ten years she held the, position of secretary of St David's Ladies Guild, and in that capacity her labours were fruitful to a degree beyond her knowledge. Blessed with the saving gift of humour, tactful, and with a fund of common sense her work remained as a tribute to her personality.

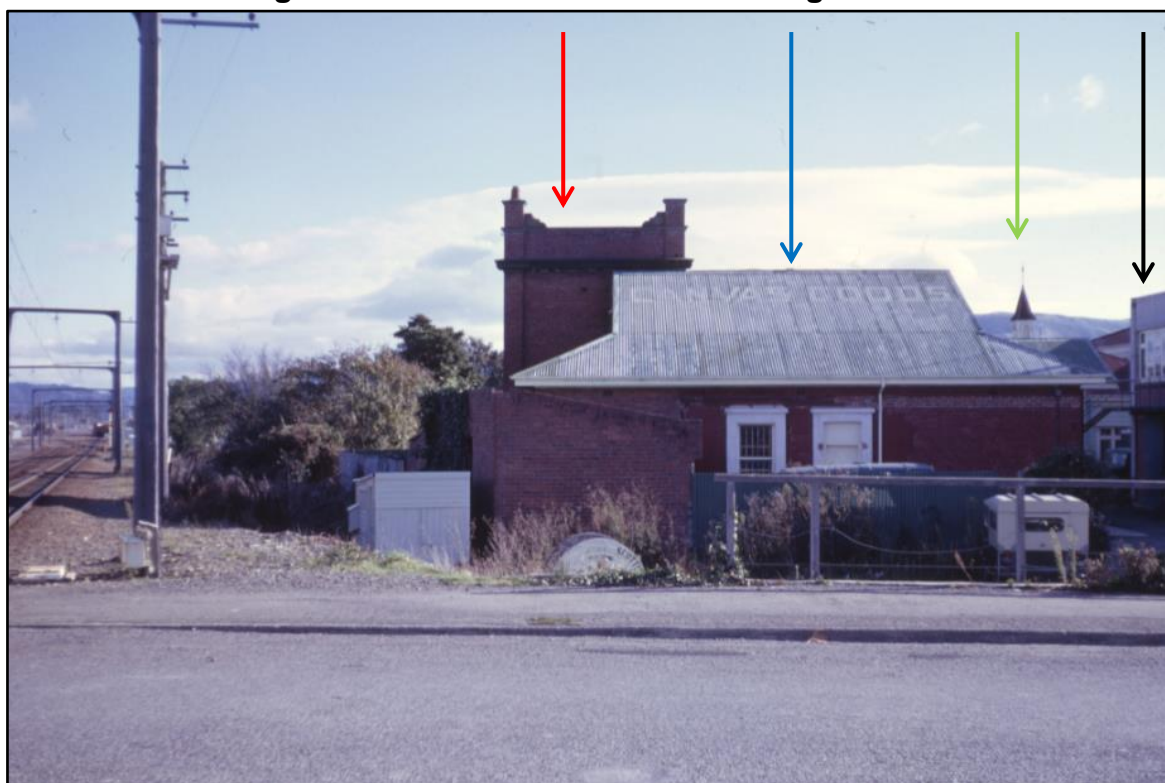
In 1937 after the death of Lydia Esther HUGGINS her estate was administered by the Public Trust. On 05 October 1950 the Upper Hutt Nationalist Club purchased the property from the public Trust on behalf of the Lydia Esther Huggins Estate.

I was informed that J H Jones occupied the building after Mrs Huggins passed away. Another person said perhaps it was Robert Henry Jones who resided Main Road Upper Hutt in 1955 but this would have been too late as others stated that the building had been demolished by 1951. The story goes that when the former Huggins private hospital building was demolished a new structure was built on the same section and named the Central Chambers.

The Huggins building was not demolished in 1951 but occupied the land behind the new Central Chambers building. A photo taken around 1967, shows clearly that both buildings occupied the same piece of land.

#Writing of Rio de Janeiro, Mr A A Huggins, builder of Petone, who recently visited the Mother Country, makes some interesting observations. After describing the city and a proposal which is a foot to rebuild a great part of it, he continues as follows - "We remembered the cry of high rents in Wellington, and curiosity compelled us to make inquiries here, with the object of comparing both places. We found three-roomed cottages with stone floors and no conveniences 25s per week. The strange thing is that wages are by no means high. Bricklayers, carpenters, masons, and plasterers get seven to eight millrays per day, equal to about 5s 9d and 10s per day our money. Labourers, 5s to 6s per day. When we reckon the cost of living, which is also high, we marvel how the workmen can live there. The cost of rebuilding will not be as heavy as in Wellington, because all the old buildings are of brick and are to be used again. The new buildings will be three or four floors higher, thus saving some of the ground lost in street widening. I am informed that the reinforced concrete for buildings is a failure, as the rods buckle and break the walls in a heavy shake, and they cannot be repaired like brick or stone. Steel frame work is being tried successfully. There are many magnificent churches, occasionally one is in the way of the street improving scheme, and down it comes. We were unable to ascertain how compensation is arranged, but it cannot be on the New Zealand system, or it would cost about 50 millions, instead of the 5 million borrowed for the purpose. On the whole, it seems that in five years' time Rio will be one of the most beautiful places on earth, but for the present we cannot help but sigh for our green and beautiful little country, and long to return to the Land of the Moa reference Papers past website Dominion newspaper 15 October 1908
