Upper Hutt 21 July 1880

To the Honourable the Minister of Justice of the Colony of New Zealand – Wellington

We the undersigned Electors & residents of the Upper Hutt district, understanding that it is the intention of the Government to abolish the Police office which has been established upwards of twenty years would earnestly ask that the question may be reconsidered. We would respectfully urge that in our opinion it would be a most impolitic step and if persisted in would entail very great inconvenience and annoyance to your memorialists and others. We therefore hop that you will be enabled to accede to the request that the office be not abolished.

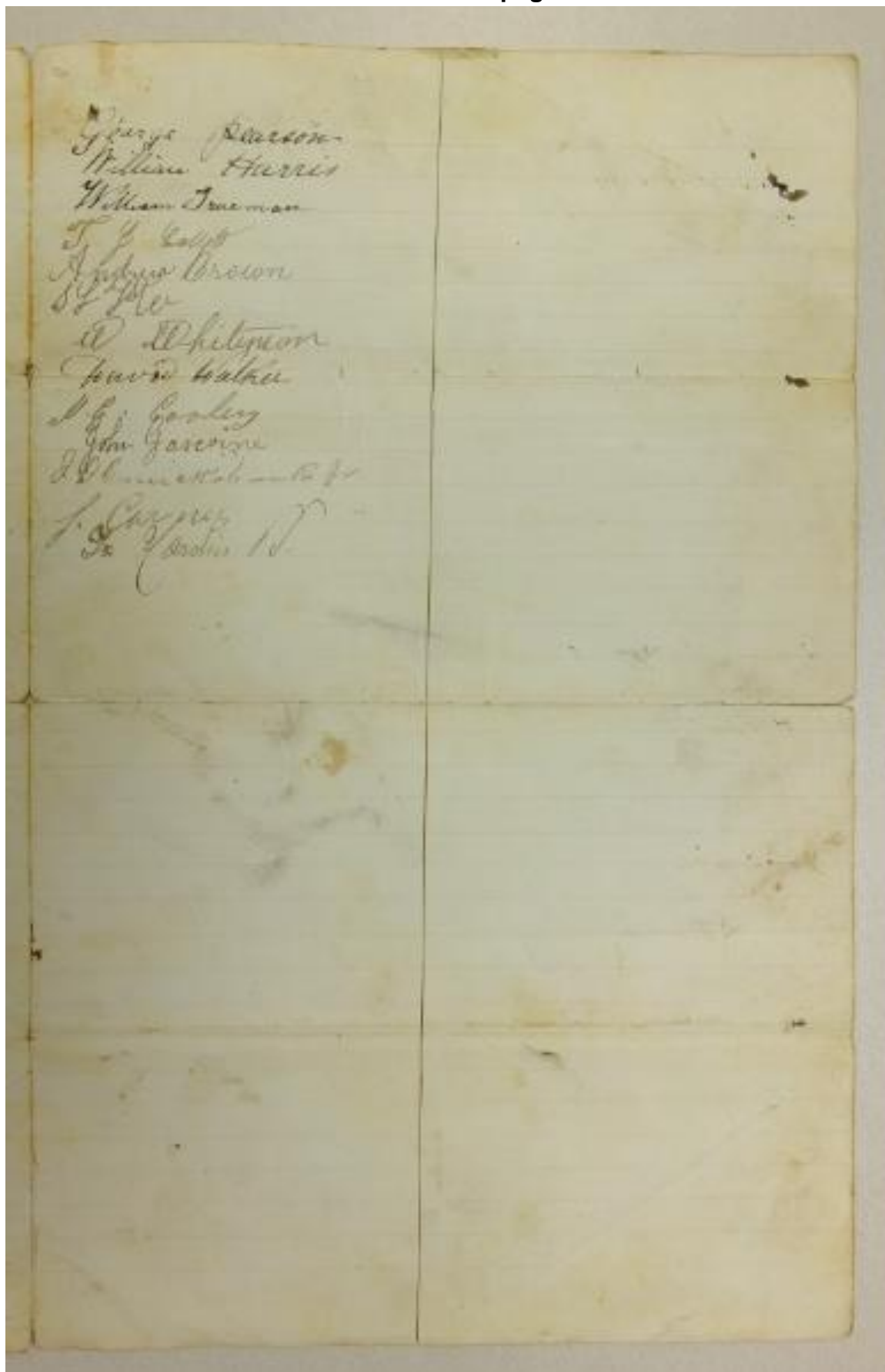
