On various documents William's occupation was recorded as carpenter and farmer.

William MARRIS occupation was a carpenter dwelling at Rowston bought a farm and 60 acres in Walcot Fen near Billingham where around 1838-1840 he built a two-story brick house for his family and servants. The 13-room house named 'Walcot Fen' was made of brick and later suffered from subsidence and had to be demolished by the Gilbert family around 1999. A new dwelling was built just behind the original old house that William Marris built in 1838. The fourth generation of the Gilbert family were still farming the 60 acres around the year 2000.

William and Elizabeth's son William MARRIS did not appear on the 1841 Census with the family. I believe he was an apprentice living at another residence.

William MARRIS aged 60 years occupation Farmer died on the 07 March 1858 at Walcot sub district of Billingham registration district Sleaford in the county of Lincoln England. Cause of death cancer 5 years as certified. The informant was Joseph UTTING from Walcot who was present at the death. The death was registered on the 10 March 1858 and signed by the registrar Wm STEWART [sic].

- William MARRIS (Emma's grandfather) married Elizabeth HANNAH who was a cousin to Dr Hannah President of St Johns College Sheffield.
- Elizabeth HANNAH also had a brother who was Dr of Medicine.
- Emma Elizabeth MARRIS was baptised in St Johns Church Sheffield.
- William Junior presented Betsy Anne UTTING (his 2<sup>nd</sup> wife) with a book entitled the "Poetic Works of Henry Kirk White" "To B.A. UTTING Walcot Fen from William MARRIS 16 Oct 1860."
- Emma believed that Betsy Ann had some money and assisted with the purchase of the Waimea Road Store in Nelson New Zealand.
- Betsy taught music & also taught Emma. Betsy may have been Emma's governess before she married Emma's father William MARRIS. Betsy spoke very well & was a fine looking woman big but not beautiful. Both Emma & Betsy were well educated & spoke well.

The Baroness Burdett COUTTS - She was a very wealthy woman who in 1837 inherited the 'immense' wealth of her great grandfather "Thomas COUTS the banker". She spent a lot of her money in later years, in helping poorer people and

those who were unable to help themselves. She married in 1882 (1881) to Mr William Ashmead BARTLETT “who ably assisted her” in her work. She lived in her beautiful London house in Stratton Street.

Note: “The Baroness married Emma MANSSEN formerly MARRIS cousin. He may or may not be the above named gentleman”.
