The family history of William Thomas FROST and Amy Elizabeth PAGE

Amy Elizabeth PAGE was born on the 11 July 1868 at Suburban North Nelson. Her father William PAGE registered her birth on 12 August 1868. William could not write and he made an X as his mark.

Amy went to Clifton Terrace School and passed standards III, IV and V in 1879, 1880 and 1881. Amy's last day at school was on 10 April 1884. Her destination upon leaving school was stated as Homes Duties and she was aged 15 years nine months.

Amy's name never appeared on the 1893 Electoral Roll even though she was old enough to vote. As I have mentioned before this was the year that women began to vote in New Zealand. I have noticed that a high percentage of the PAGE girls were late in taking up their right to vote which leads me to believe that they were not in support of the women's suffragette movement. Their mother Caroline also did not appear on the electoral roll until 1899, which was the third term that women had the right to vote.

Amy Elizabeth PAGE age 25 years married William Thomas FROST age 29 years occupation farmer on the 15 January 1894. They were married by the Anglican minister Rev J De BURGH GALWAY at St Andrews Church Hillside Wakapuaka. The witnesses were Bertha and Florence PAGE (Amy's younger sisters) and Lewis G FROST a Framer of Wakapuaka. I believe Lewis was one of William's relatives.

William Thomas FROST was born in 1864 at Wakapuaka NZ. His parents were George occupation Butcher and Mary Ann FROST. George FROST married Mary Ann NORTHAM in 1863 at Nelson.

The ship Sir Charles Forbes arrived in Nelson on 22 August 1942. Part of the passenger list is as follows

Amy and William first appeared on the Nelson Electoral Rolls for many years living at the same areas of Suburban North, Wakapuaka, Happy Valley, Hira and lastly at "Tharlswood" Wakapuaka Nelson. They lived all their married life in the same district where William farmed in the Ludd Valley in Hira or Happy Valley as it was called then. Amy used to make separator butter and sold it in 1lb nett weights. Amy and William FROST had five children the oldest and only daughter named Amy Elizabeth FROST after her mother. Then there was William George, Lawrence Cyril, Eric Cecil and Norman Stanley FROST. The family were great ones for nicknaming their children, which made things a little hard for me at the start of my research as Amy was Lizzie, William was Jack, Lawrence was Mac and Eric was called Sam.

Living female FROST wrote a biography on her grandfather Lawrence Cyril FROST. I have extracted some of the contents with her permission to provide some insight into the FROST family life. Lawrence talks of his parents thus making the family very real to us all.

Back when my mother and father owned an old house about one mile up Happy Valley Nelson. I can remember growing up there, our home small and shabby only four rooms including the bathroom and washhouse. An iron wrap-around veranda sheltered the house from the wind and the rain. A large old totara tree grew beside the house and it was a favourite place of mine to play in during the day. Inside the house my mother used a big old "Ryan Range" to cook from. It was also used to heat water meaning a fire was essential throughout the day to ensure hot water when my father arrived home form a days work on the farm.

We however would spend the afternoons running around outside playing in the totara and helping my father in the garden after he'd worked for the day. Mr elder sister Lizzie would often help my mother with the cooking and the women's chores. When night finally came we'd use kerosene lamps, candles and my father phonograph to brighten the long winter evenings. In the summer though the only reason you came inside of a night was when you were ready for bed. I recall growing up with my family as a pleasant experience. My mother and father were both wonderful parents, but my mother was something extra special. I came into the world born in the old house up Happy Valley.

The writer continues with her grandfather's recollections and the biography is well which is worth reading. I did not originally intend to publish all of the contents in this

chapter but upon reconsideration I decided it really belongs to the writer and hopefully the writer will one day put it all into print for other members of the Frost family to read. Please take up the challenge and write about the FROST family who arrived on the Mariner in 1849 and include the biography on that dear man Lawrence Cyril FROST.

Amy Elizabeth FROST died on the 10 June 1937 at the Nelson Public Hospital at the age of 68 years. She was buried on 12 June at the Hira cemetery. The Rev D.G. SPENCER an Anglican minister took the service. Amy and William FROST had been married for 43 years and 5 months.

William continued to live at "Tharlswood" Wakapuaka until his death on 20 May 1950 at the age of 85 years. William was buried next to his wife Amy.
