Conrad Marris MANSSEN was born 31 December 1882 Stoke Waimea Nelson. His parents were Emma Elizabeth MARRIS age 30 years born Sheffield England and Charles Frederick MANSSEN age 34 years born Nelson occupation Labourer. C F MANSSEN father of Stoke registered the birth on 17 February 1883. The registrar was Robert KIRTON. (Reference RGO NZ birth registration 1883 folio 488 and web reg. 1883/ Nelson district)

Conrad went to Stoke School. Before his parents moved to Toi Toi Valley in 1896 Conrad went to live with his spinster aunt Mary Elizabeth MANSSEN. He then attended Clifton Terrace School. His date of admission to the school was 25 September 1893 by which time he had passed standard II. He passed standards III and IV in 1895 and 1896. On his Clifton Terrace School it records Miss MANSSEN as his guardian.

Life for Conrad must have been very hard coping with the farm and attending school at the same time. It was always a problem in those early years for children. They were required to help out on the farms and often their schoolwork or health suffered as a result. In 1897 Conrad left Clifton Terrace School. I believe he returned to live with his parents in Toi Toi Valley. I have been told that Conrad used to walk from his parents home in Toi Toi Valley to Wakapuaka to help his sick aunt on her farm.
