The family history of Francis Moss MANSSEN and Letitia Mary REYNOLDS

Francis Moss MANSSEN was born on 07 January 1889 Stoke Nelson NZ. His parent's were Emma Elizabeth formerly MARRIS age 36 born Sheffield England and Charles Frederick MANSSEN age 40 years born Nelson NZ occupation labourer. His parent's married 03 June 1874 Wellington New Zealand. E. E. MANSSEN mother of Stoke registered the birth on 18 February 1889. The registrar was Robert KIRTON.

(Reference RGO NZ birth registration 1889 folio 540 line 29 Nelson district)

Francis who became known as Bob was the youngest son to be born to Charles and Emma MANSSEN.

I believe Francis went to Stoke School then later Nelson Boys Central.

The Buller Electoral Roll for 1911 and 1914 had Francis living in Chamberlain Street Westport with his occupation stated as Painter. It is interesting to note that quite a few Manssen descendants took up the trade of painting.

Letitia Mary REYNOLDS was born on 02 December 1894 at Westport. Her parents were Emily and Charles REYNOLDS

On the 07 December 1914 at the residence of Mr Charles REYNOLDS in Westport Francis Moss MANSSEN aged 25 occupation House Painter married Letitia Mary REYNOLDS aged 20. The Rev J T BURROWS a Presbyterian minister married them. The witnesses were Ernest Edward REYNOLDS Cordial Maker of Westport and Florence Emily REYNOLDS. Ernest and Florence are probable close relatives of Letitia. Letitia was under age so her father Charles REYNOLDS gave written consent to the marriage.

Letitia was born on 02 December 1894 at Westport and came from a family of 10 children. Her parents were Emily Letitia DE CLIFFORD and Charles REYNOLDS occupation Clerk.

Charles REYNOLDS aged 33 years occupation Rabbit Agent married Emily Letitia DE CLIFFORD age 17 years on 07 January 1885. The minister Frederick John SOTHAM took the service at Saint Johns Church Waikouaiti. Emily Letitia DE CLIFFORD was born in Croydon Surrey England. Her parents were Letitia PEARCE and James DE CLIFFORD Hotel Keeper. I do not know when James DE CLIFFORD and his family came to New Zealand.

Charles REYNOLDS was born in Portugal. His parents were Maria Gertrudes DIAS/BRANCA and Thomas REYNOLDS a gentleman. Thomas and Maria REYNOLDS arrived in Dunedin in 1851 on the Titan along with their younger children including their son Charles. Later their three older children Thomas, Mary and Robert arrived in Dunedin on the John Masterman on 1857. They came to New Zealand with their grandparents Marion (formerly HUNTER) & Thomas William REYNOLDS, their uncle William Hunter REYNOLDS (single), aunt Eliza Hunter (formerly REYNOLDS) MACANDREW, her husband James MACANDREW and 1 child Colin MACANDREW plus other passengers and servants. (Reference we are gratefully acknowledges the assistance from Living Female DONALDSON who is researching the REYNOLDS family.

After the marriage of Francis Moss and Letitia Mary MANSSEN I was unable to find any trace of them until 1922 when they both appeared on the Wanganui Electoral Roll as living at 13 Ingestre Street.

According to the birth registrations of their children they lived in Blenheim, Westport, Wanganui then Tauranga. Two children were born in the South Island and the other three Francis George, Mavis Emile and June was born in the North Island.

On the Electoral Rolls of 1925, 1928 and 1931 they lived at 120 Harrison Street Wanganui then in 1935 they moved to 36 Heads Road, Wanganui. Sixth Avenue Tauranga was to be the next move in 1938. Francis's (Bob) occupation was always recorded as Painter on all Electoral rolls until his retirement.

From 1941 to 1943 Hunter Street Tauranga was home then Munro's Flats, Mount Maunganui from 1946 to 1949.

Ocean Beach Omanu Mt Maunganui was to be their last shift and the last home they would share.

A photograph was taken in 1912 at Gisborne of the Westport Garrison Band, which included Francis Moss MANSSEN. The band was in Gisborne for competitions years later Francis wrote these words on the back of the photograph to his youngest daughter June.

"This photo was taken in Gisborne. I stayed in Gisborne for six months after the contest and worked for Hall and Sons. Tommy HARDLE and I left Gisborne by boat (there was no road out of the dump those days). We left in the morning. The Star of Canada was wreaked on the reef just outside of harbour we had to go out in a lighter

to get on board the Monowai it took three hours of very rough seas and had to be hauled on board by winch in a basket. What a trip and wasn't everyone sick.

Stayed with Albert HODGSON 416 Gladstone Road Main Street.

On a lighter there was a parson and his wife with a young Baby, they were too ill to look after the baby so I took it from them and looked after it till we got on board. I was young and fit and it was no trouble. (I have never forgotten that experience. What it is to be young). As soon as I arrived on the Monowai I met an old school mate of mine by the name of Tommy WALKER. He was purser on the boat but what happened after I have no memory. Was offered a job on a ship (Liner) at Napier but turned it down. If I had taken the job what a change in my life it would have been. Instead I went to Westport and you know the rest. Pop."

Living Female COLLETT sent me these details but she said the writing was faint, as apparently his pen wouldn't write.

We found it interesting the travel of such a distance in those days from Westport to Gisborne just for a contest. It showed Francis MANSSEN's great love of Brass bands as other family photos show him still attending in 1937. Perhaps this could have also been the cause of deafness from which he suffered in his later years.

Francis Moss (Bob) MANSSEN aged 89 years died on 08 February 1978 at Tauranga Public Hospital and was cremated in Tauranga on the 10 February. Francis and Letitia had been married for 63 years.

His parent's were Emma Elizabeth formerly HARRIS (should be MARRIS) and Charles Frederick MANSSEN occupation general labourer. Francis was age 20 when he married Letitia Mary REYNOLDS in Westport. His widow was age 84 years and living issue were 3 males age 63, 61 & 60 years old and 2 females aged 55 & 53 years old. F L JONES funeral director of Tauranga registered the death on 13 February 1978. The registrar was E B TUFFER [sic]. (Reference RGO NZ death registration 1978 folio 4798 line 63 Tauranga district)

Letitia continued to live at 72 Ocean Beach Road, Mt Maunganui for many years until she could no longer look after herself. She then moved into a home in Tauranga and on 30 November 1990 Letitia passed on at the age of 96 years. She was cremated at Tauranga.
