#Employer's Liability - Far-reaching provisions of the Act - Judgment in an important case concerning the dependence of an inmate of an industrial school has been lodged by the Court of Arbitration with the clerk of awards (states the Wellington Times). The Public Trustee represented by Mr J. W. Macdonald was plaintiff in the action and Joseph Auguste Perano (Mr A W Blair) was the defendant. The main facts of the case as determined by his Honor Mr Justice Sim are that plaintiff is the administrator of the estate of Patrick (Peter) Tiernan who was employed as a seaman on defendant's steamer the Wairau. On December 20th last Tiernan while engaged at Havelock on work in connection with the mooring of the vessel was accidentally drowned. His only dependent was an illegitimate son born on November 9th 1904. Tiernan had been living with the boy's mother for some years and about the end of 1907 she was sentenced to a term of imprisonment for forgery. After her arrest the boy was committed to an industrial school and Tiernan was by consent adjudged to be the putative father and ordered to pay 7s per week for his support. The payments were in arrears by about £20 at the date of his death. During the last year of his life Tiernan had paid only £8 5s under the order. The mother had not contributed to his support since he went to the school. In 1908 the boy was boarded out by the Education Department for 7s per week the guardian providing him with food lodging and clothes any further expenses in connection with his maintenance being paid by the Department. The Public Trustee alleged that the boy was a total dependent of deceased and claimed compensation on that basis. The only question at the hearing was whether the boy was to be treated as a total or partial dependent the defence of serious and wilful misconduct having been abandoned. In the opinion of the court the boy was wholly dependent on the earnings of deceased. The question of arrears of payment could not affect the point to be determined. Judgment was given for plaintiff for £325 to be invested by him and capital and income applied as though proper.
