> An Ordinance for the Naturalisation of certain German Settlers in the Colony of New Zealand. [16th July 1844]

Whereas certain Germans, being the persons particularly described in the Schedule to this Ordinance annexed, have recently settled in this Colony, and Her Majesty has been graciously pleased to assent to the removal from them (within this Colony) of the disabilities to which aliens are by law subject:

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of New Zealand, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:-

1 All and singular the persons who are particularly described in the Schedule hereunto annexed shall be, to all intents and purposes whatsoever within the Colony of New Zealand, deemed and taken to be and to have bee, from the fourteenth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three, natural born subjects of Her Majesty, as if they had respectively been born within the realm of England.
