Cause was death was cerebral haemorrhage sudden senile debility hemiphlegia cerebral haemorrhage six months as certified by Dr B E WRIGHT who saw him last on 17 October 1940. His father was recorded as Stewart Leckie occupation manufacturer but there were no details regarding his mother. He was cremated at Karori 26 March 1941 by Presbyterian minister J A SCARROW. Stewart was age 27 when he married Lillian Annie SEAGAR in Auckland. His living issue was 2 sons age 42 & 28 years and 2 females age 46 & 44 years.
