The house at 785 Fergusson Drive Upper Hutt was built 1950 and the Funeral Chapel was built in 1951. The property was sold 31 October 1994 and again in 28 August 1996, then 11 April 1997, and on 13 December 1999 it sold for \$116,000 (*Reference Property Value NZ website*)

The Springgay building at 785 Fergusson Drive was purchased by the "Kool Kidz". This was a child care facility that closed in 2022.

The former Funeral chapel building at 785 Fergusson Drive was given an earthquake sticker in 2023.
