In 1947 and 1949 Buchanan & Edwards (Footwear Trade) situated in Railway Avenue Lower Hutt were advertising for Staff in their Lower Hutt factory.

Enjoying a glass of Buchanan whiskey van de Velde remarked “Buchanan is damn good whiskey and Edwards is a damn good footwear man and therefore Buchannan and Edward will be the new name”.

Dunlop New Zealand Limited - Manufacturer

The Dunlop Tyre Factory in Upper Hutt was opened by Rt. Hon Peter Fraser on 10th June 1949

Dunlop Gumboots had been advertised as early as 1936 in New Zealand newspapers but it is not known when the Dunlop New Zealand Limited factory began manufacturing rubber footwear.

In 1970 Rubber Footwear were manufactured by Dunlop New Zealand Ltd in Blenheim Street Upper Hutt.

Number One Shoe Warehouse

Around circa 2000 the Number One Shoe Warehouse was first opened at 21 Queen Street Upper Hutt.

Later the Number One Shoe Warehouse moved upstairs into the Upper Hutt Mall.

Then later still the Hannahs Shoe shop merged into the same premises as Number One Shoe Warehouse and became known as Number One Shoes & Hannahs.

Pepperell Cliff Ltd - Retailer

Around 1947 Cliff Pepperell Ltd once situated Main Street Upper Hutt.

The proprietor of the business was Clifton Rae Pepperell. It was a family business and when he retired his son Kevin managed the family business.

Cliff Pepperell had started in Hazelwoods, and bought Charlie Anderson's menswear business in 1947.

Cliff Pepperell Ltd later expanded into women's wear. The original building was demolished and replaced in 1974.

A Pepperell's Drapery in Merton Street advertised a summer sale of ladies' and children's wear and manchester in the 02 February 1966. The advertisement gave full details of how to find the shopping centre.

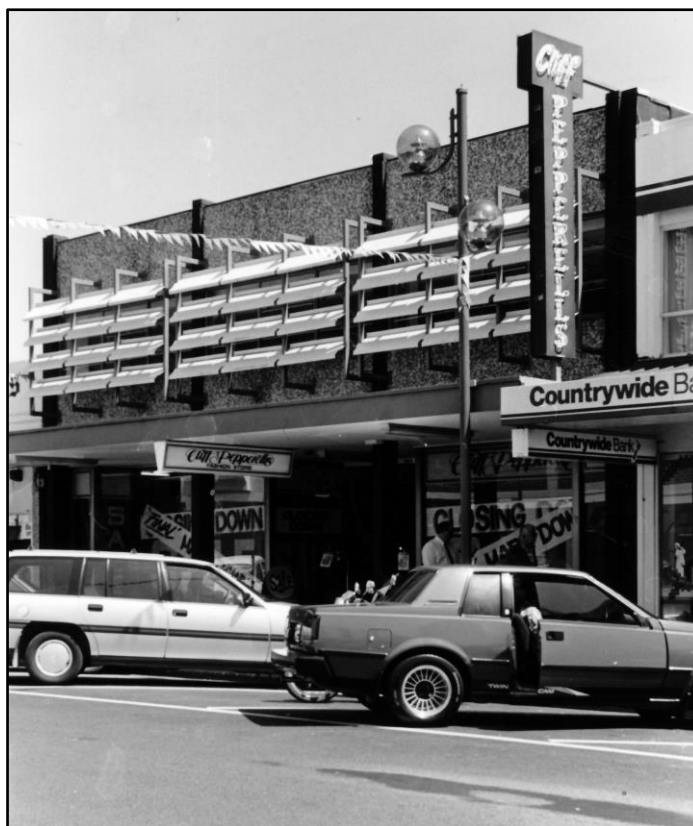

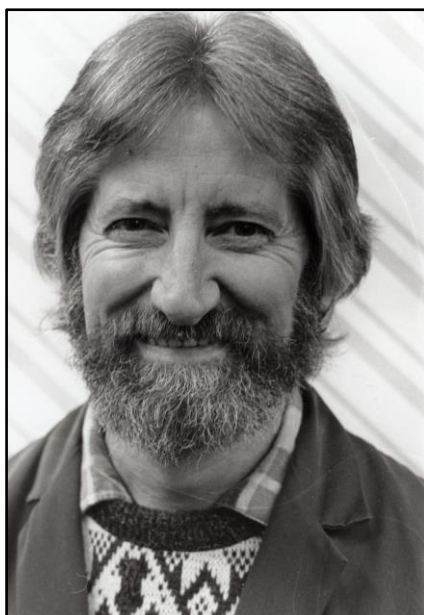

There's not much Graham Hall of Edser's Footwear Repairs doesn't know about repairing shoes. He has been doing that in Upper Hutt for 35 years. In 1957 at the age of 15 Graham began work in the second storey of the Logan Street building where the City Plaza now stands. He recalls looking out onto the paddocks across the road from his work. It was in the Logan Street shop known as Rapid Footwear Repairs that Graham served his five-year apprenticeship in shoe and boot repairing under Tom Edser, with whom Graham has worked all his (working, please!) life.

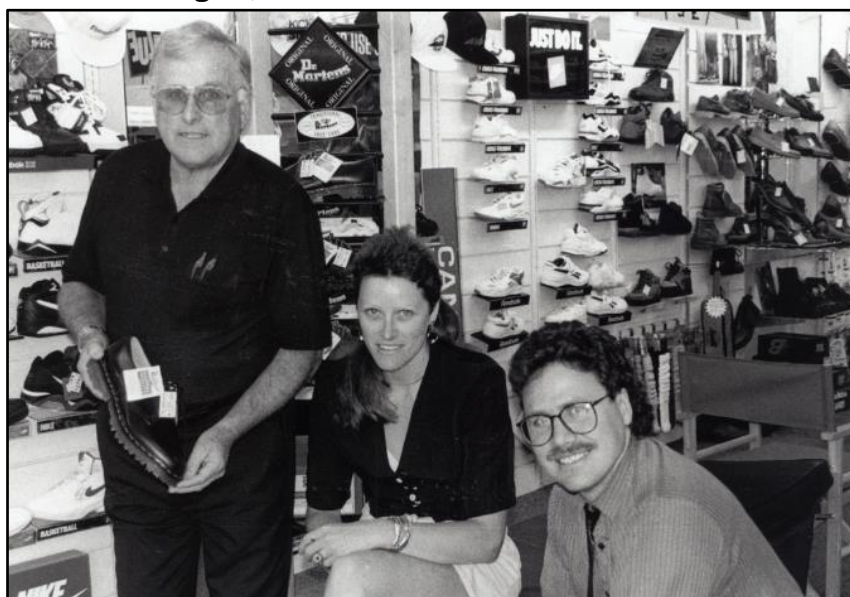
