There were ten firms advertising in a 'We love doing business in Upper Hutt' feature; 'Recollect' has two views of Main Street and pictures from three of these advertisements; this is one.

The name had changed from 'Hair Extensions' to 'Acada' in September 1996.

Owner Maureen Wagg fell in love with the character house with its distinctive roof turret, bought it in 1988, and obtained council permission to use it as a beauty salon. Soft Sun Villa of Beauty moved in from Maidstone Mall ('Leader', June 7, 1988.)

In 1998 the beauty salon occupying it moved closer to the centre of town and Mrs Wagg converted it back to a family home.

No names were given for the large group.

[Photo] At left the premises of Farmers can be seen, the Company took over the business and these premises, from Fabers Furniture Coy. in 1963. Later on 19 April 1982 Farmers began trading on the opposite side of the street in the Clouston's Corner 'building, corner Main and Wakefield Streets. The shops beyond Farmers would soon be demolished and become part of the Maidstone Mall site. The block housed a 'GHB' grocery, Brailsford Real Estate, **the Caravelle Beauty Salon**, and a sports shop at the far end. The empty section beyond had been the site of the 'Brunswick' (formerly the 'Armidale') Private Hotel. Father Breen both at church and the cemetery in which many hundreds of people attended. Some beautiful floral tributes were placed with the casket coming from many organisations in the district. Landmark 43 Ward Street building Villa of Beauty has gone full circle and is being offered for sale as a private home again. Owner Maureen Wagg fell in love with the character house with its distinctive roof turret and bought it prior to a 07 November 1987 auction and then obtained council permission to use it as a beauty salon. Soft Sun Villa of Beauty moved in from Maidstone Mall ('Leader', June 7, 1988.) Ten years later the most recent beauty salon occupying it has moved closer to the centre of town and Mrs Wagg is converting it back to a family home. She says the house was built in 1906 for 860 pounds by a member of the Whiteman family for a Downing relative. Originally the house had servants' quarters and an orchard. "It's sad to part with it, I hope someone buys it and will love it as much," she says. "People loved coming here to visit it." The house is for sale by private tender. The business changed its name from 'Hair Extensions' to 'Acada' in September 1996.
