Evening Post newspaper clipping 30 October 1968

Water enters Shopping Centre – Water from the creek overflowed also into the Brown Owl shopping centre about two and a half miles north of Upper Hutt at about 8.30 am. The water was across the footpath and reached just inside the doors. The lawns of the neighbouring Baptist Church were under water but by 9 am the creek level had dropped and flooding receded. Shopkeepers had sandbags around their doors. This is the fourth occasion the creek has flooded the centre which contains about seven shops.

The Brown Owl Fisheries business established perhaps in 1980 but it is not known who the first proprietor was. The shop situated in the Brown Owl shopping centre.

Comment – I do not know whether the Brown Owl Fisheries was established in 1980 or the website was established in 1980 but we can confirm that the business was operating in 1984. (Reference Yellow a true brand website)

I was told that a Mr Jenkins or Mr Jarvis owned the Brown Owl Fisheries shop. It was once the last shop at the end of the building but was relocated to the first shop after the Post Office was closed. I have been unable to confirm if either Mr Jenkins or Mr Jarvis was the proprietor of the Brown Owl Fish and Chip Shop.

There was also a mention of a Mr Lakis at the Brown Owl Fisheries shop. I have been unable to confirm who Mr Lakis but believe he may have been Foundou**lakis**.

I was also informed that Ari [sic Harry] Foundoulakis a Greek formerly of Clouston Park Fisheries became the proprietor of the Brown Owl Fisheries shop. Harry's real Christian name was Charalambos.

The 1987 Heretaunga Electoral Roll confirmed that Harry Foundoulakis resident at 96 Clouston Park Road was a Shop Proprietor

On the 10 July 2001 Harry handed Mrs Jacky Hunt her fish and chips parcel and as they were both walking towards the doorway of the shop Harry collapsed. Mrs Hunt's children were sitting in the car waiting for their mother to return with their fish and chips when this all happened. She immediately phoned 111 then began CPR until help arrived then she went home. Later she was informed that Harry had a massive heart attack and died before hitting the ground. The next day Mr Jacky Hunt placed flowers next to the shop.

Charalambos Foundoulakis age 53 businessman died 10 July 2001 and was buried at Akatarawa cemetery plot 401 area plaque 2 denominations Greek Orthodox. Headstone - In loving memory of Charalambos Foundoulakis 24.03.1948 – 10.07.2001 loved husband best friend & soul mate of Barbara cherished and loving dad of Spyridon, Efstratios, loanns & Kyriaky. A mighty oak has fallen.
