## Dominion newspaper 28 February 1917

Man Killed at the Summit – Simpson A Auld, a surfaceman in the employ of the Railway Department, married and with three children, was accidentally killed at the Summit by being run over by a train. The facts as gathered from the police are that Auld on returning from his work last evening alighted from the train which stopped close to his house. There was a goods train at

the station also, that was being shunted, and just as Auld crossed the line the goods tram backed out on the shunt, the unfortunate man was knocked down and 15 trucks passed over him. The body was brought into the city, and is now at the morgue. An inquest will be held. (Reference Papers past website Dominion newspaper 28 February 1917 page 6)

### Evening Post newspaper 28 February 1917

Fatal Railway Accident - Man Killed at The Summit - Details of a railway fatality at The Summit reached Wellington last evening. The victim was Simpson A Auld, a railway surfaceman, who was a married man with three children. The report received by the police shows that Auld was returning from his work at about 5 o'clock last evening, and he alighted from the down train preparatory to proceeding to his home. In attempting to cross the railway line he was knocked down by a goods train, and thirteen wagons passed over his body, death being apparently instantaneous. The accident occurred within a very short distance of deceased's home. The body was conveyed to Wellington, and an inquest will be held at 2.15 o'clock on Friday afternoon.

## Wairarapa Age newspaper 28 February 1917

Wellington Last Night - The news has just been received of a shocking railway fatality at the Summit station, near Cross Creek. At about 5 o'clock this evening a surfaceman named Simpson A Auld was almost instantaneously killed. Auld had alighted from the down train and was crossing the lines to go to his house nearby. He faded to notice another train hacking from the siding and was knocked down by it. Fifteen wagons passed over his body, mangling it frightfully. Auld leaves a widow and three children. The accident happened within about a hundred yards of his home.

# Hutt Valley Independent 03 March 1917

On Tuesday, Simpson Allen Auld, platelayer, was killed near his house at the Summit. Getting off a train he walked towards home. A string of loaded firewood trucks were on the track behind him. Apparently, he did not hear the trucks moving when being pushed from the far end. Anyhow, when guard Elliott, on to engine, came along on the next track, he was horrified to see Auld's body cut to pieces and disembowelled, strewn over the track fifteen loaded trucks had passed over him. Deceased, who leaves a wife and three little children, was buried at Trentham yesterday afternoon.

From particulars to hand we learn that the two in company with a trucker named Bert Jackson were working (between heading's No 16 and No 17. A sudden fall of debris overwhelmed Auld and Duggan but Jackson had a miraculous escape as he had just moved his truck from the spot where the fall came. Jackson immediately gave the alarm to the other miners working in the vicinity and they at once set about the work of getting out the covered men. It was at first though that both were killed but after the rescue work had been in progress a short time the workers heard the voice of one of them calling for help. They worked with redoubled vigour and they soon ascertained that Duggan had been providentially protected by a piece of timber which had been knocked away by the fall and which had formed a protection over him. He was soon got free and it was found that with the exception of severe bruises on the body he had escaped without serious injury. He was at once conveyed on a stretcher to the miners surgery and was examined by Dr Telford who had been promptly summoned as soon as the accident was known. It was found that the debris had caught Auld on the head and neck. After the body had been got out Dr Telford used artificial respiration for half an hour but without success. The only mark of injury was a bruise at the back of the head and Dr Telford expressed the opinion that death was due to asphyxia. The deceased, who arrived from Scotland three years ago was about 35 years of age.
