## Manawatu Standard newspaper 24 October 1936

Pahiatua 21 October – In the Magistrates Court yesterday before Mr J L Stout S M, George Sterndale Bates poultry farmer of Upper Hutt, Marjorie Bates wife of the former and Albert Arthur Marryatt assignee of George Bates estate sought to recover from the Pahiatua County Council special damages of £33 17s and general damages of £25 a total of £58 17s. The Magistrate ruled that the claim of Albert Marryatt be struck out on grounds of his being wrongly included as a plaintiff. Obituary George Sterndale Bates – The death occurred on Monday 22 April of Mr George Sterndale Bates "Oamarania" Upper Hutt. The late Mr Bates was for several years in business at Upper Hull as a poultry farmer Gibbons Road (where the present Government Demonstration Poultry Plant is situated). During the first World War Mr Bates served overseas rising to the rank of Major. He leaves a daughter Mrs Rosalie Paylon Masterton to mourn his loss. The burial took place today Friday at the Soldier's Cemetery Masterton after a service at St. Mathew's Church Masterton
