Presentation at the Hutt - A very interesting ceremonial took place at the Upper Hutt, on Monday week. Mr J Cruickshank, Captain of No 3 Company, Upper Hutt Militia, in consequence of the very regular attendance of the men belonging to the company, some coming the distance of eight miles or more, had determined to show his appreciation for their attendance and excellence of their drill by presenting the most successful competitor with a small token of his esteem. After the usual a movements of the day, and the company about to be dismissed, <u>James Bayliss</u> was called to the front. Captain Cruickshank after a few general remarks touching the very excellent order and discipline of the company since its formation, presented him with a silver medal, remarking that his steadiness of conduct as a citizen soldier as, well as citizen, was deserving the highest praise, he trusted the present proceedings would bind in stronger bonds the kindly spirit that dwelt in their midst. The gallant captain's remarks were received with loud cheers. Mr

<u>Bayliss</u>, who appeared to be taken by surprise, briefly returned thanks for the honor conferred upon him, and begged to assure his captain and brothers-in-arms the events of that moment would not be easily or soon forgotten, his remarks were received with cheers. The obverse of the medal consists of two rifles crossed from which is suspended a waist belt, pouch, &c; a ribbon interlaced has the word, "*Upper Hutt Militia*", at the base on a scroll, "*Established 1863*". The reverse, contains - presented by Captain J Cruickshank to <u>James Bayliss</u> as the best shot at short range, 250 yards, - January 25, 1864, - No 3 Company, - surmounted by a scroll with the motto "*Pret pour mon pays*". The above medal was made and most elaborately engraved by Mr J H Marriott. After the dismissal, the medal became a source of attraction to all, who were loud in their praise of the liberal donor and the recipient. Thus ended a day which we trust is but the prelude to many such interesting gatherings.
