Offences on the Road - Upper Hutt Court - A number of cases arising out of breaches of the highways and motor regulations were heard in the Upper Hutt Court yesterday by Sir J S Barton, S.M. George Archibald Campbell was charged with having an overloaded lorry on the Akatarawa - Waikanae Road. The Main Highways Board traffic inspector Mr J E Ainsworth, said the limit on the road was 4½ tons, but the defendant's lorry, of which he was part owner, weighed 6 tons 8cwt 2qr 24lb, and he had a special permit from the Hutt County Council to have a lorry loaded up to 6 tons. Mr A J Mazengarb, who entered a plea of guilty for the defendant, said that Campbell Bros, were the only users of the main part of the road, and by special arrangement with the County Council did all the repairs to the road. The two bridges were mainly used by Campbell Brothers and when one bridge was swept away they paid £75 towards building a new bridge, and provided all the timber for it. Another bridge was in need of repair and Campbell Brothers were asked for the same contribution towards it. In these circumstances Campbell Bros, had no reason for overloading. There were no means of accurately, checking the weight of lorries at the timber mills. Mr Ainsworth said that the defendant used five miles of the main road. The Magistrate entered a conviction and imposed a fine of 10s.
