Robert McGiffert CLELAND was born 1836 Belfast Antrim Northern Ireland to parents Mary nee McGiffert and Hugh Cleland. Robert's brothers were Hugh Cleland and Joseph McGiffert Cleland and they settled in New Zealand.

The ship *Maori* departed London and arrived via Nelson into Wellington New Zealand on 21 July 1853. The passenger list recorded Messrs Cleland etc. I am unable to confirm if this was when Robert CLELAND arrived in New Zealand or if it was one of his brothers.

Mary MABEY was born 02 April 1839 Branscombe Honiton Devon England to parents Harriet nee Croom and Charles Mabey.

Memorial of Mr Robert CLELAND

His Excellency Sir George Grey K C B Governor and Commander in Chief

in and over the Islands of New Zealand

The humble memorial of Robert CLELAND of the Upper Hutt in the Province of wellington Draper and Grocer.

Shewth - That your Memorialist was charged before J R Willis Esquire Resident Magistrate Upper Hutt aforesaid with having sold less than two Gallons of Spirituous liquor on the 05th September last.

That your Memorialist admitted to having sold Two Gallons of Gin to Robert Douglas of the Upper Hutt Labourer on the said 05th September and that the said Robert Douglas took away at that time two bottles of Gin part of the same 2 gallons and the remainder within eight days afterwards. That your Memorialist having permitted the said Robert Douglas to do so was entirely through ignorance and without the slightest intention of your Memorialist infringing the law.

That your Memorialist was fined on the 19th January last the Penal sum of fifty pounds and costs four months after the alleged offence and contrary to the Summary Licensing ordnance.

[missing part of letter] Memorialist humbly prays [missing] will take a favourable view of the above case and [missing] of Fifty Pounds and costs and [missing] as in duty bound will ever pray.

Sir

With reference to the Memorial in the case of Robert Cleland which you have sent to me to give my opinion on. I have the honour to inform you that on the day on which that case was heard. I allowed a second charge against Robert Cleland for the illegal sale of spirits to be withdrawn solely in consideration of the heavy fine which I had no discretion but to inflict. I have also reason to believe that Robert Cleland was frequently in the habit of selling spirits contrary to the provisions of the Licensing ordnance. Taking the above into consideration I considered at the time that R Cleland had been most leniently dealt with.

Mrs Mary Cleland, relict of the late R M Cleland, whose much regretted death took place recently at her residence, “Branscombe” Upland-road Kelburn, was a pioneer resident of Wellington. With her parents she arrived in New Zealand from England in 1841 and had lived in Wellington for practically 77 years. She experienced the severe earthquakes in 1855. Possessing a remarkable memory many an interesting incident of the early outbreak of the Maori War was narrated by her. repeated and abused proverb of live and let live. A short time ago one of our most successful and wealthy flax spinners bought a property in the county of Down under the court part of it consisted of an island in Strangford Lough. The land is very good with an abundant supply of sea-rack which makes good manure. After the purchase was completed he went to see his property and the tenants on it. When he met them they all pulled off their hats to their new landlord but the first words he said to them was Put on your hats I want no cringing serfs on my property but independent men and then added that he would never allow them to pull off their hats to him that they were met on equal and independent terms to transact a matter of business that he had land to let and they wanted to hire it and therefore he begged them to retire and consult as to what rent they could afford to offer him for it. They shortly returned to say that they thought they could safely undertake to pay him 30s per acre for their first class land for which their former landlord charged them 48s. He told them he was quite satisfied with their offer that the rent should not be higher than that and further that he would give them leases of three lives or 32 years of their respective holdings. These facts I had from a gentleman in the commission of the peace who was present on the occasion and was greatly delighted with the whole scene. What a contrast does the conduct of the aforesaid merchant present to that of many of our land agents who may be seen in the little country towns where they reign paramount walking the streets with two or three tenants after them with their hats in their hands while the white hair of venerable old ago may be seen fluttering in the breeze and I am told it frequently occurs even in Ulster that if a tenant going into an office to pay his rent inadvertently neglects to uncover he is sure to be treated to a most insulting lecture for his want of good manners How supremely ridiculous would such conduct appear in one of our first class merchants for a couple of hogsheads of sugar. Yet the two cases are exactly parallel except that in nine cases out of ten the merchant is greatly superior to the land agent.
