17 Years Chairman Of School Committee - Mr T Clyma and Trentham School - After 17 years at Chairman of the Trentham School Committee Mr T Clyma has resigned not seeking re-election this year. Mr Clyma joined the Trentham School Committee on 14th February 1929 and in April of the same year was made its Chairman which position he held continuously, having been elected every term to the same position. When he joined the Committee the Trentham School was only a small place of two rooms with about 80 pupils but during his occupancy of the chair he has seen the school grow to its present position with about 236 pupils. He was a great advocate for open air schools and Trentham was actually the first school in the North Island to install open air class rooms in its real sense. Another fine asset to the school has been the Swimming Bath which Mr Clyma and his committee did all possible to raise the necessary money to finance it (Mr J Purvis senior having first of all donated a certain sum to commence the Baths). Mr Clyma has been Chairman during the sojourn of six headmasters and all have had nothing but praise for his work for the school and the children. He has represented Trentham School on the Dental Clinic since its inception where he has also pulled his weight. As a member of the Upper Hutt Borough Council he has served under three Mayors Messrs McCurdy, Robertson and the present Mayor Mr J Blewman and it is hoped that he will continue to be a member of that body for many years to come.

During the Queen Carnival held in Upper Hutt for the purchase of Barton's Bush Mr Clyma was a very enthusiastic and active member of the Carnival Committee and left no stone unturned to achieve file Committee's object. For many years "Tom" has been a popular playing member of the Upper Hutt Bowling Club and his presence will be sadly missed by the members. At the meeting of the Transit Housing Committee on Monday a vote of condolence was carried to Mrs Clyma and family in their sad loss.
