James and his family resided in a dwelling attached to the Post Office which was situated on the corner of Station and Main Street in Upper Hutt. Not far away in the Main Street was the Benge and Pratt store.

On the night of the 28 March 1914 a fire broke out in the Benge and Pratt store in Upper Hutt. Volunteers under the guidance of local Constable Denis Mahoney began removing goods and equipment from the store while James Comeskey removed the telephone. James being the local Postmaster was responsibility for the telephones as they were government property. He went to remove a second telephone from the Edwards building which was attached to the store when an explosion took place.

James Comeskey died on the 29 March 2015.

I have the honour of calling to your recollection a conversation between yourself & myself in reference to the representations made to me by the relatives of those who lost their lives during the Explosion at the Upper Hutt. You will doubtless remember sending telegrams of condolences to the relatives of the injured, after obtaining their addresses from me. It is of that occasion I write. I informed you at the time that the relatives required my services professionally to advise them daily and to act for them during the inquest proceedings & in advising in their claims against Benge & Pratt & C, and I asked you, Sir, whether the Government under the circumstances would pay the legal charges for them. You may remember Sir, that I informed you that if your Government would not pay the costs, I would do the work for nothing as I did not intend charging the widows and those who were left a single penny. I am still of that mind. Mrs Comeskey who has been generously dealt with has asked me what she owes me & I have told her she owes me nothing, & I have adopted that attitude all through. You will remember you informed me that your personally thought that I should act [sic] & that you personally thought the Government would be willing to recommend that the relative should not bear the cost, this you informed me that you would have to see Mr Herdman on the subject. Whether the matter has escaped your notice I do not know, but at any late I am sure you will pardon the reminder. In conclusion if you think that the Government should not pay, that is an end to the matter for all time, I shall not bother again on the subject & the work will not be charged for.

Comeskey Grove in Upper Hutt was named after one of the Comeskey family but which one. Some say it after the caretaker (perhaps James Francis COMESKEY) of St Joseph's Orphanage & Convent in Gibbons Street Upper Hutt. Comeskey Grove is situated on the former farm land of the St Joseph's Convent.

James and Sarah Jane COMESKEY lost 2 sons during World War One and 1 grandson in World War Two. In 2014 these three Comeskey Service Personnel were recorded on the War Memorial plaque outside the Upper Hutt City Council chambers on Fergusson Drive in Upper Hutt.

Next to this War Memorial plaque is another plaque recording the names of the eight men who lost their lives in the Benge and Pratt fire and explosion of 1914. Recorded on this plaque is James COMESKEY.

The memorial plaques outside the Upper Hutt City Council chambers record the names of three generations of the COMESKEY families of Upper Hutt.
