The divorce suit of Hilda Edwards against W H Edwards, was heard by the Chief justice this morning. Mr Gray was counsel for the petitioner, respondent was not represented. Evidence was given that petitioner at fifteen years of age was married in 1899 to respondent, who was

then aged 21. Shortly afterwards (in 1900) he left his wife, without giving any reason, and though he returned to the Upper Hutt district after a short absence he had not written to witness nor spoken to her. He had not contributed anything to her upkeep. It was understood that respondent left his wife because of some dispute between her father and himself. His Honour granted a decree nisi, with costs on who lowest scale.

Upper Hutt Progress - Pioneer Stables - Bravo, Harry - Away back in the Fifties a Paisley Scot (James Brown) and his family trekked from Alicetown, to Rongonui (the place of great reputation) now known as Upper Hutt. There was no road between the two places just a rough track into the dense bush of the Nai-nai and Taita, from the lower valley clearings, a Maori track over the hill into Stokes Valley, across the creek, and up and over the eastern hill (the Hutt river ran at the foot of the cliffs at the northern end) to near the railway bridge, and thence by the track denned by the birch bush on its southern side and totara forest on the north, to the site of the Upper Hutt township (then surveyed into 100 acre blocks) and onward to the distant Wairarapa. Along this tortuous and difficult track came Upper Hutt's Pioneer Settler James Brown, senior, and his family, with their possessions in a small cart - the cart being taken apart and the body and wheels carried by the party over the two intervening ridges to what is now known as the Silverstream. The family put up their first shelter of saplings and sailcloth at "Rongonui" and thus established the pioneer European residence in Upper Hutt. A slab whare replaced the first shelter, and was followed by a dwelling of pit-sawn timber which was later on used as an inn and known as "The Shepherd's Inn". At a subsequent date additions were made to the building and the name was changed to "Criterion Hotel". It was here that the Duke of Edinburgh (brother of the late King Edward VII) stayed in 1865. The hotel was sequently closed and the bulk of the internal walls removed to permit of its being used for entertainment - the tenant (J B Dalton) naming it "Dalton's Hall" and occupying the old bar room as a cobbler's shop. The property at this stage was part of the "Barnard Rhodes Estate". The buildings were pulled down and the block of land having become the property of C T Price, was subdivided and offered at auction. The purchasers of the main road allotment (old hotel ground) being T P Boyd (vacant land and part of bar room site, on which he erected a shoeing forge and, later, added a coach factory), H E Pratt (balance of the hotel site and site of the "pioneer residence) since sold to **W H Edwards**, and on which he has erected an up to date reinforced concrete stable, offices and motor garage. **M Pudney**, since sold to Boyle Bros., on which reinforced concrete motor repair shop and garage is being erected, and J Brown, since transferred to Len McKenzie, the Wellington

chemist. On the boundary line of the last two lots is the well-known oak, grown from an acorn planted there in the Fifties by Pioneer settler James Brown of Paisley, Scotland. The new stables and garage built to the order of **W H Edwards** by F H Luckins, at a cost of over £1000, is one of the best in the Dominion. There is accommodation in a fireproof structure, for a number of cars, stalls for horse's line the opposite side of the central passage, and convenient storage provided for fodder horse-stalls. The whole of the main building is fitted with a high-pressure water service from the town board mains and a complete drainage system has been provided. The remainder of the allotment has been roofed in to provide shelter for carts and other vehicles. Concrete drinking-troughs, a concrete manure-pit, and an acetylene gas-plant are installed in this portion of the establishment. There are two convenient offices on the street frontage and in rear thereof are harness, feed and groom's rooms. A veranda of neat design sets off the exterior to advantage. The proprietor did intend to name the building the "Criterion" Stables, after the hotel that formerly occupied a portion of the allotment, but on hearing from a member of our staff that it was also the site of the abode of the first European settler in the district, he decided to call it the "Pioneer" Stables and Motor Garage to commemorate the fact. Bravo Harry. Here's Luck to your Enterprise.

Lorry's Fall Karapoti Gorge Accident Driver Killed - A tragic accident .happened in the Karapoti Gorge beyond Upper Hutt yesterday afternoon when a lorry laden with timber fell from the narrow gorge road into the bed of the stream below. The driver of the lorry William Henry Edwards of Martin Street, Upper Hutt aged 58 a married man with four children received injuries which must have caused immediate death. The lorry was smashed to matchwood. Three other men were in the truck at the time of the accident. They were Christopher Marshall, Alfred Francis Cooper and Joseph Alfred McHugh. McHugh and Cooper were riding on the outside of the lorry, but Marshall was with Edwards in the cab. The accident happened about 3.30 pm at a spot half-way between the new mill and the site of the old mill, about three miles from the junction of the gorge road leading to the sawmill and the main road. At the spot where the accident happened there is a rocky bluff, and the lorry had just passed through this when it left the road. The gorge road is a narrow one, but at this spot it is better than in most places and one who knows the road well says it is about ten feet wide at the point concerned. The lorry laden with timber was travelling from Campbell's mill at a slow speed when it started to leave the road the three men who were passengers in it managed to jump clear. They are unable to give any reason for the accident. There are steep cliffs above at this place and below they are so steep that it is impossible to climb down them. The men returned to the mill and telephoned to the Upper Hutt police who arrived at 4.30 pm and the Free Ambulance, which arrived at 4.45. Block and tackle had to been rigged before the rescuers could descend the cliff and bring up the body of the driver. Very severe head injuries had been received. The truck was smashed almost beyond recognition. The steep cliff was marked with signs of its descent and debris was scattered about the bottom of the gorge. There was nothing to check the fall of the vehicle once it left the road. The deceased is a well-known resident of Upper Hutt. He was in the employ of Messrs Campbell Bros., saw-millers of Karapoti and for the past ten years had been driving along the gorge road. He had lived in Upper Hutt all his life and his father was one of the early residents of the district. The late Mr Edwards was formerly a well-known carrier and carried on the business now known as Robertson and Dick. The bank over which the lorry fell is .200 feet high. An inquest will be held.

Fatal Lorry Accident – Only Inches to Spare – Wellington this day – A finding that deceased was accidentally killed as the result of the lorry he was driving leaving the road was returned by the coroner at the inquest concerning the death of William Henry Edwards, who was killed at Karapoti Gorge last Thursday.
