Township of Wakatiki (Emerytown) was a 1913 development in the Upper Hutt district. In early years Wakatiki / Whakatiki was referred to as Moonshine. The land was owned by J Emery of part section No 92. The Department of Lands records read "*There is no town in the immediate vicinity and the name suggested is Wakatiki with Emerytown as an alternative*". Stephen Street was dedicated in 1913. In 1924 Charles Edward Clark owner and developer of Township of Wakatiki Extension No 2 included additions to the north side of Stephen Street.
