Major J T Hazelwood - The death occurred on Friday last of Major J T (Jimmy) Hazelwood at his residence in Henry Street Upper Hutt. The late Mr Hazelwood who has been ill for over 12 months was a popular person in the district and was connected with many sports bodies during his lifetime in Upper Hutt. After leaving Nelson College Mr Hazelwood was employed in the Hutt Valley, then for a while at Hazelwood's Department Store. When World War II broke out as a territorial in the Upper Hutt Platoon he volunteered for overseas and left New Zealand with the 2nd Echelon as a Sergeant. Returning to New Zealand through ill health he immediately joined up with the Home Guard and became its Adjutant. From there he was appointed to the position of Railway Transport Officer at Wellington Railway Station where he was in charge of all train and ship movement in and around New Zealand. Promoted to the rank of Major he continued as R.T.O. until the end of the war and many service personnel has him to thank for his advice and co-operation. At one time he was an active member of the-local football team playing for Upper Hutt in the early thirties. After the second world war Mr Hazelwood became a member of Hutt Bowling Club where he was a most popular member also he was secretary of the Social Committee of the club for a couple of seasons. Although his life was always tied up in military maters from a youth new found time to become a member of the local Borough Council for one term where his knowledge of finance was most helpful. The name of Hazelwood is a household figure in Upper Hutt as the late Major Hazelwood's father founded that business 60 years ago. Incidentally Mr J A Hazelwood (senior) is still alive and living in Upper Hutt. The deceased leaves a wife two daughters and one son to mourn him also several brothers and sisters. The funeral took place at the Lawn Cemetery Akatarawa on Monday and was fully represented by members of the local R.S.A. of which he was a member and for several years the Marshal for the Dawn Parades on Anzac morning. The funeral service was conducted in two phases the first at the Mortuary Chapel by Mr A (Bert) Wickham and at the grave side by Mr R Whiteman. The pallbearers at the funeral were near relatives at the chapel and at the cemetery it was carried out by Returned Servicemen. Among the many hundreds present at the service were the Mayor Mr R H E Slacke, the President of R.S.A. Mr M S Quigley, Mr Pete Wilkie, many business people also members of the local bowling club (men and women)
