An elderly lady, Mrs Hounslow, senr., Masterton, aged 78 years, fell between the wheels, and was dragged some distance before getting clear of the vehicle. She expired shortly afterwards. The other occupants were Mrs Hounslow, junr., and her daughter, 12 years of age, who managed to jump clear of the buggy without injury. The mother, however, was less fortunate, and in jumping fell on her knees

and chest, with the result that she sustained several nasty bruises, and a severe shock to the system. The driver, Mr Hansen, got severely shaken and bruised, and sustained a slight wound behind one knee. The body of the deceased lady was brought into Poole's Hotel about 5 pm, and the other sufferers arrived soon after. The latter, according to latest reports, are progressing favourably. Much sympathy has been expressed for the sufferers in their sad bereavement. An inquest will probably be held tomorrow.

The Buggy Fatality - Further Particulars, How Mrs Hounslow Met Her Death - Feilding This Day - The cause of the sad death of the late Mrs Hounslow was the bolting of a pair of horses attached to a buggy in which she was travelling at the time from Feilding to Rangiwahia, on a visit to her daughter, Mrs A W Rule. A passenger from Masterton to Rangiwahia, after leaving the train at Feilding, usually travels by coach to Rangiwahia but a double-seated buggy and pair was specially engaged, in which the party were to drive to their destination. When within a few miles of the end of their journey, the horses got control of the driver, and bolted down a steep hill. The driver either fell or jumped out. Mrs Hounslow, senr., was thrown out, and through her mackintosh catching in the brake, she was dragged for some distance. When she was picked up she was almost unconscious, dying within a few minutes. Mrs H Hounslow and her daughter, who were travelling with Mrs Hounslow, senr., jumped out, the former escaping with bruises, and the latter without any injury whatever. The body of deceased will be entrained for Masterton to-day, and the funeral will take place there on Friday.
