Borough population has more than doubled over the past ten years in 1951 the population was 7,800 and now in 1961 is 16,588. If over the next ten years this rate of increase continues, careful and wise spending of borough finance must be the key-note.

Local taxation is a heavy burden on the home owner and as direct ratepayers are in the main young working people and old folk endeavouring to get a home together they should not have the constant fear of an increase in rates. Just as the housewife caters for her home and family and keeps within the limits of her husband's income so should the Council endeavour to look to the needs of the borough and keep within the reasonable limits of its finances. I fully realise that the borough has many problems and also that these problems cannot be solved overnight. One of the problems that must be looked into is the problem of room for development but I believe that if Government buildings particularly departments were co-ordinated in some central area in the borough excess Government property could then be released for further development. It is my belief that if all essential works are carried out first and long term loans are secured for the development of our Parks and Reserves, rates can be held more stable and we can look forward with confidence to our City of Tomorrow.

It reappeared in the 14 June 14 1977 Leader when 31 Upper-valley residents received Queen's Jubilee Medals. In that year's council election she came fourth to Rex Kirton who was elected mayor. 23 September 1980 Leader she stood for council and came top of the 11 candidates for 8 places in the City ward. It was reprinted in the Leader on 21 January 1986 when she was awarded a Queen's Service Medal after retiring from the city council at the 1986 election. She had been a city councillor community advisory service chairman Townswomen's Guild patron and more. Date taken August 1974.
