These natives are described as a very ferocious and ill-looking set and though not over numerous on any case of emergency are reinforced by some of Rauparaha and Rangihaeata's mob besides all the Maories from up and down the Straits. They also receive an accession of numbers from Wairarapa. Mr Clarke the Sub-Protector went up to the spot on receiving information accompanied by a native but the latter refused to go to the pah alleging that his countrymen would tomahawk him. Mr Clarke then proceeded by himself but however the natives of Te Aro and Pipitea may submit to his guidance these natives are not inclined to do so and we are given to understand that they soon got into a rage with the Sub-Protector for his trouble and threatened him by word and gesture which soon obliged him to retire. The same natives have since given notice that they are going to take possession of a section for which our late lamented Mayor was agent. It is reported that the natives have determined to settle in large numbers in the Upper Hutt and clear a large quantity of land there. They quickly estimate the value of a good road to a good market nevertheless the Company cannot afford to expend their means for the Maori convenience in this manner and we hope at no distant date the new Governor will convince these people of the impropriety of squatting by ejecting them.

An unfortunate accident occurred yesterday to Mr Job Mabey an old Taita settler who was unloading a cart of hay at the Bank Hotel Manners Street when he slipped and fell sustaining a dislocation of the shoulder. He was attended by Dr Rawson and Mr Monteith and the dislocation being reduced Mr Mabey who is over 70 years of age was kindly driven to his country home in a buggy by Mr Wakeford the landlord of the hotel who was most assiduous in his care for the sufferer.

Inquest - The sudden death of George Mabey who fell down in Willis Street on Saturday morning last and died within a few moments formed the subject of a coronial enquiry at the Morque this morning before Dr Johnston the District Coroner when the following evidence was taken. Michael Wallace labourer deposed that on Saturday last shortly after 9 am he was in Willis-street and when opposite the grocery store of Mr Young he saw deceased lying on the roadway at the back of his cart. Witness went to the man's assistance and raised his head and remained with him till he died which occurred within about five minutes from the time be dropped down. The deceased died before Dr Gillon arrived. Deceased did not speak after falling down but he breathed stertoronsly [sic] just before he expired. He appeared to have fallen during a fit. George B Young grocer Willis Street stated that he had known deceased for ten years past and on Saturday last he was delivering chaff and had brought in a 501b bag of chaff. He returned to his cart and witness shortly after this saw deceased lying in the street as described by the last witness. When deceased first went to witness shop he spoke and appeared to be in good health. He was very quiet and hardworking man and was a Wellington native. Dr Gillon who had made the post mortem examination gave evidence to the effect that on Saturday morning last he was called to see the deceased whom witness found lying in the middle of Willis Street near the Empire Hotel life being extinct. Witness endeavoured to restore animation by artificial respiration and other means but failed in the attempt. The post mortem examination disclosed the fact that the internal organs were very much congested but structurally they were quite healthy. The brain was healthy in structure but it was slightly congested. In witness's opinion the cause of death was failure of the action of the heart caused by a sudden spasm. The death was attributable to natural causes. Job Mabey settler at the Taita father of the deceased deposed that his son left home on Saturday morning shortly after 6 o'clock with a load of produce at which time he appeared to be in his usual health and he made no complaint of feeing unwell. Witness overtook decease in another cart at Ngahauranga and spoke to him when he seemed to be quite well. This was the last witness saw of deceased alive. Witness sometimes complained of pain in his heart and stomach but he never was laid up. The jury returned a verdict in accordance with the medical evidence.

A typical old colonist Mr Job Mabey whose features have been preserved for posterity by the artist's brush of Mr J M Nairn died at the Taita this week quite unexpectedly at the age of 86. He was buried in the old Taita Cemetery yesterday morning the Rev Mr Jones conducting the service.
