Upper Hutt Town Board Election - The biennial election of Upper Hutt Town Board took place yesterday. Keen interest was taken. There were fourteen candidates for seven vacant seats. The voting was - Messrs J Blewman 342, C T Jones 312, A J McCurdy 283, J Martin 270, J Greenwood (re-elected) 243, T S Burrell 237. The ex-chairman Mr W Greig secured sixth place with 238 votes. The other candidates were Messrs W J Robinson 210, Osborne 178, Kitchen 156, Guthrie 148, Seller 110, Rogers 138, and Goss 93. Of a total roll of 1014 names of which nearly a quarter were not residents of the district, over 50 per cent recorded their votes. Over 75 per cent of the resident electors were polled both percentages being Dominion records in local body election.

Mr James Martin - After living in Upper Hutt for the 88 years of his life Mr James Martin died recently. His mother, who arrived in New Zealand with her parents in 1840 lived to be over 90. His father Alexander Gordon Martin settled in Upper Hutt in 1850. Mr James Martin married a daughter of Mr Charles Cudby another old settler Mrs Martin predeceasing him in 1932. He joined the Railways Department as a youth and retired in 1918 after more than 40 years of service. Mr Martin was a member of the Upper Hutt Town Board for some time and was also a prominent member of the Roman Catholic Church. He was one of the best known and popular guards running on the Hutt railway line for many years. Mr Martin's maternal grandparents opened the first hotel at Upper Hutt on the corner where the Bank of Australia now stands. Mr Martin is survived by two sons Frank and Basil and two daughters Mrs Daniel Boyle and Sister Eileen Norbet of Upper Hutt. His eldest son Horace was killed in the Great War. Three brothers and two sisters are also still living.
